ROTC granted six credits by Curriculum Committee

The Curriculum Committee has voted unanimously to grant six credit hours to the Reserve Officers Training Corps (ROTC) if it is established on campus. They also voted to include all 15 hours

of the program on the transcript.

The make-up of the credit is as follows.

All 15 hours will be figured in the

cumulative average but only six will count toward graduation and any form of honors. The other nine will be counted above the 122 semester hours.






