MOAKLEY URGER REAGAN TO HALT THE TRAINING OF SALVADORAN SOLDIERS IN THE UNITED STATES

Congressman Joe Maakley (D-Ma) x dispatched a letter to President Reagan in which he urgedXXXXXXXXX the President to halt the further training of Salvadoran soldiers in the United States."
