

Petition to Members of Congress

We, the undersigned, have just celebrated a religious service commemorating the First Anniversary of the martyrdom of the six Jesuits and two women murdered by the U.S.-trained Atlacatl Brigade of the Salvadoran military in the night on November 16, 1989. These killings are simply the most visible among tens of thousands committed by the Salvadoran military since 1979. Justice has not been done in this case; a massive cover-up continues.

Consequently, we want to know:

What are you doing, as a Member of Congress, to see that justice is done in this case and in the cases of so many thousands of other victims?

We oppose any U.S. war-related aid flowing to a regime that commits such atrocities with regularity and impunity. What are you doing to stop the flow of U.S. war-related aid to El Salvador?

We await your answers.
