Dear Representative Moakley,

I am outraged by Pres. Reagan's recent certification that the government of El Salvador is making human rights progress, and his intention to send more military aid to that repressive regime.

It is obvious that the murder and oppression by the El Salvadoran military is continuing unabated. Recent reports in the New York Times tell of massacres by Salvadoran soldiers, and the practise of torture by the Salvadoran military (and U.S. advisers even helping them). Aid to that regime must stop.

I urge you to co-sponsor the legislation recently introduced by Rep. Gerry Studds to end all military aid to El Salvador.
