Thank you for contacting me with your concerns for H.R. 747 which would defer the tax on student loans.

I fully support the deferral of tax on student loans as support any responsible legislation which would encourage accessibility to higher education.

The bill to which you refer, H.R. 747 is currently in the House Committee on Ways and means and has 152 co-sponsors. As you may already know the tax on student loans was instituted as part the 1986 Tax Reform Act.
