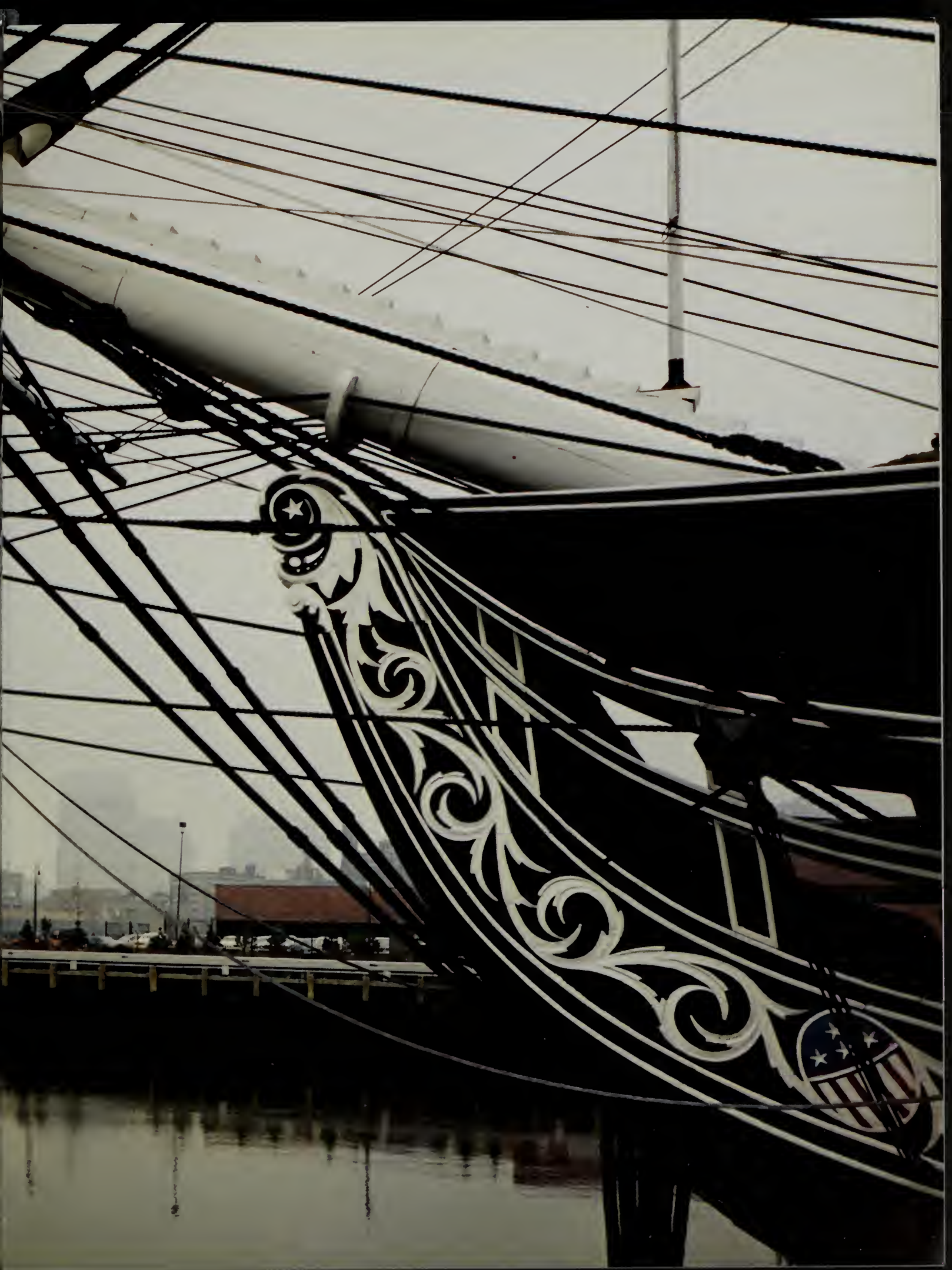






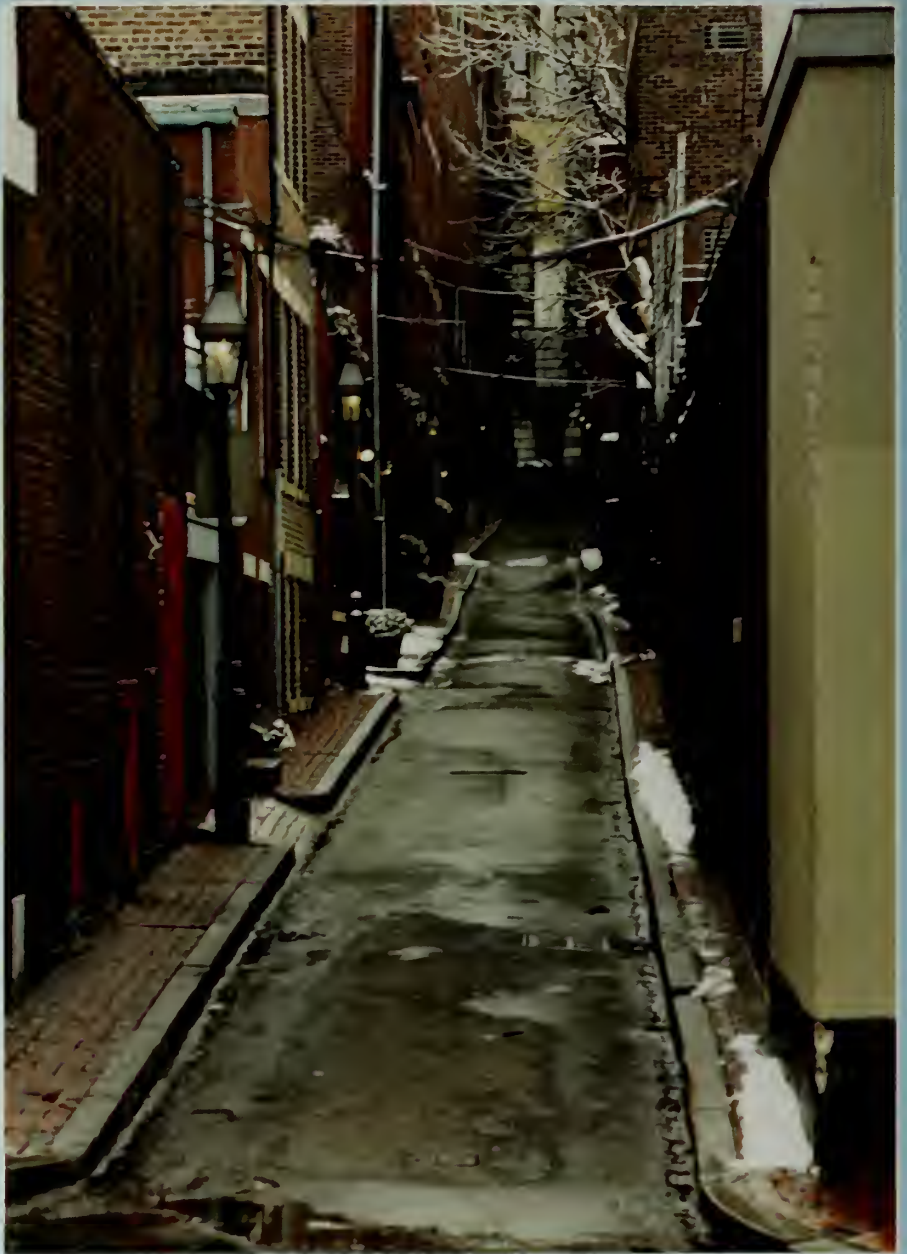




















LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

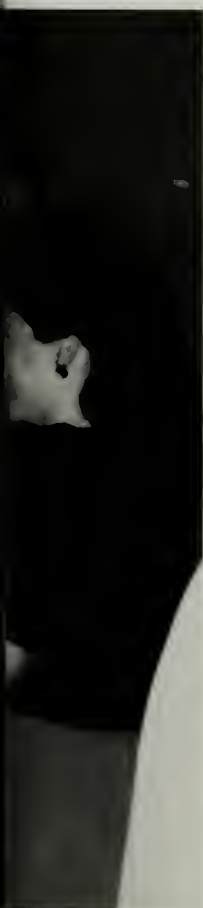



















To the Class of 1986:
