 - Have all those mentioned by the Judge agreed to comply?
 - Logistically, how will all this be done?

2) On Buckland — I've read and re-read his prior knowledge statement + his retraction. I still am not sure what to believe. In his latest retraction to the FBI, Buckland says Aviles could not have possibly told him about ^{a plan to murder the Jesuits on the day} ~~the murders~~ prior to when they happened because he claims Aviles was out of the country. It is my understanding, however, that Aviles returned to El Salvador on Nov. 14th. It leads one to speculate that perhaps Aviles did say something to Buckland. What kind of follow-up has the Embassy done on the Buckland prior knowledge statement?
