However, lwasto be disappointed because there were only three small stories about this "BIC story" inall of the localpapers. And the rewas not even a sixty second film clip on the six

Clock news
The Homan Life Amendment is an amendme * which has been circulating through Congress since 1973. However, it has never gained upport because of the majority of lineral and Democratic Congression which have been in the

Congress for the pastfewsessions. Congress for the past few sessions.

The amendment, written in three succinct sections, would require the fetus to be considered a person with full Constitutional rights, and would prohibit "a law permitting only those medical procedures required to present the death ofthemother.

If the amendment shouldpass, it would mean an end to all abortions, even incases of rape and incest. It would mean that the Pill. ILiD, and other forms of birth control would brillegal. It would mean that every miscarriage or spontaneous abortton would be miscatigated to see if it was accidental or intentional, thus subjecting the accused to criminal prosestition. And finally, it would mean that mouthly pregnancy tests for all women of child pregnancy tisses for an women of child bearing age may be required, along with the registration of every pregnancy or suspected pregnancy.
