
Dear Rep. John Moakley:

The Women's Plea for Human Rights for Soviet Jews, representing thousands of women nationally, will be observed on December 10, 1979, International Human Rights Day.

Here in the Boston Area the Greater Boston Council of American Mizrachi Women will convene the observance for the 1979 Women's Plea, to take place at 12:00 noon on December 10, 1979 at Boston's Faneuil Hall. Keynote speaker will be Congresswomen Margaret Heckler, long active in the cause of human rights. There will also be a performance of the famous Soviet Actor Clowns - the Kozhevnikovs who will perform the play "The Refusnick" - which they feel is a true story about Moscow Refusnick life. The program is scheduled to last an hour and we hope for maximum media coverage.
