Dear Mr. Secretary:


This will authorize Representative John Joseph Moakley and two staff members, James P. McGovern, professional staff with the House Rules Committee, and William Woodward, Staff Director of the Subcommittee on Fisheries and Wildlife Conservation, to travel on official business to El Salvador from June 28 - July 2, 1991.

The purpose of the trip is for Representative Moakley, as Chairman of my Special Task Force on El Salvador, to continue their efforts in the monitoring of the Salvadoran government's investigation into the November 16, 1989 murders of six Jesuit priests and two women at the University of Central America in San Salvador.

It is requested that the local currencies for per diem with a subsistence allowance to cover any incidental costs, and transportation, including local transportation, be made available. Authorization for the expenditure of funds should be made available in accordance with Section 502(b) of the Mutual Security Act of 1954, as amended by Public Law 95-384.
