This will authorize Representative John Joseph Moakley and staff members, James P. McGovern, professional staff with the House Rules Committee and William Woodward, Staff Director of the Subcommittee on Fisheries and Wildlife Conservation, to travel on official business to El Salvador from June 28 - July 2, 1991.

The purpose of the trip is for Representative Moakley, as Chairman of my Special Task Force on El Salvador, to continue their efforts in the monitoring of the Salvadoran government's investigation into the November 16, 1989 murders of six Jesuit priests and two women at the University of Central America in San Salvador.

Expenditure of funds for the payment of actual and necessary expenses and such transportation as may be required is authorized by 31 U.S.C. 1108(g).


