Re: Recommendations regarding travel to El Salvador and health
precautions

I have been in touch with the Attending Physician's Office and the Centers for Disease Control's International Travel Office regarding precautions for El Salvador the following recommendations have been made by these offices:

Attending Physician:

For those traveling to rural areas (particularly at night and dusk when mosquitos are most prevalent) malaria suppressors are recommended. One pill is taken weekly beginning the week before the trip and continuing for a month after the trip.

A Gamma Globulin shot is recommended to prevent Hepatitis A and infections.

BOTH MALARIA SUPPRESSORS & GAMMA GLOBULIN ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE ATTENDING PHYSICIAN'S OFFICE IN H-166 IN THE CAPITOL

Centers for Disease Control-International Travel Office:

Malaria suppressors are recommended for rural area travel, particularly if spending the night.

In areas of bad sanitation, Gamma Globulin is recommended for protection against Hepatitis A.

Care should be taken with regard to food and drink. Drink only bottled water, avoid uncooked fruit and vegetables (eat fruits only if you peel them yourself, eat only hot, cooked foods).

Dengue Fever (a mosquito borne illness) is prevalent in urban areas of El Salvador. Insect repellent is recommended.

Tetanus and polio shots should be up to date. (tetanus-once every ten (10) years, polio-one (1) shot in adulthood).
