MISCELLANEOUS PROTSIONS. CHAPTER 441

TOY PISTOLS, Etc.
if any person shail have in his possession a toy PISTOL OR OTHER TOY FIREARMS, FOR THE EXPLOSION OF BLANE CARTHIDGES, WITH INTENT TO SELL THE SAME, OR SHALL SELL OR OFFER TO SELIL OR TO GIVE AWAY THE SAME, OR SHALL HAVE IN HIS POSSEssion an air hifle with hiee nitent, he shail be fined not more than fifty dollars, and shail be lable for all damages besulting from a violation of the provision of this sec. ton, to be recovered in an action on the case.

## SELLING TOBACCO

 TO MINORSif any person shall bell ctanrettes or tobacco IN ANY OTHER FORM TO $\triangle$ MINOR HE SHALL BE FINED not more than fifty dollabs.

GIVING TOBACCO
if any person other than the minor's parent or guardian shall give or deilver any ciaabeties, SNOFP, OR TOBACCO IN ANY OF TTS FORMS TO ANY MINOR UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE HE SHALLL BE FINED NOT MORE TEAN FIFTY dOLLARS.
