Here follows a doscription of the church
The new edifice is situated upon the corner of Man honse occapied. The estornal appearance of the hulding is
an example of modern Gothic, so generally used in England ${ }^{\text {at }}$
crowned with an ornate stone cross. The oxternal dimencrowned with an ornate stone cross The oxternal dimen-
sions of the whole edinice, church, vestibule and vestrs,
which are all on one floor are $50 \times 110$ feot, 14 foot story orshich are all on ono floor are $50 \times 110$ feot, 14 foot story, es-
wlusive of projection of tower and vestry. The internal dnensions of tha audienco room are $48 \times 70$ and 26 ? feet high. The roof is open and is supported by handsomely fuishod
trusseg. It is lightod by nino orul-topped stained trusses. It is lighted by nino oval-topped stained glass win-
doome, the artistio design of which surpasses anything of it
ind in kind in this seciion of tho state. Tho mottoes and emhiews
on the windows are: I. H. S., Cross and Crown, Anchor and Tily. The largest mindow is in the east, facing the chancel,
somicircular, of variegated colors and nuch beauty. The somicircular, of variegated colors and much benuty. Ther
are also four triangular windows in the roof. The churel contains seventy-tiro semi-circular slips which will convenien Iy accomroodate 432 persons. The platiorm is aliout 2 tho entire auditorium. The singers' seats are on the same lovel, in thio rear of the pulpit, to the right and the left, giv
ing ample room for the transepts nad chancel. In the nume
and diate rear of tha pulpit is the organ of beautiful design manufactured by Rider of Boston. Back of the platform is
the vestry and ladies' parlor, divided from the audience room the vestry and ladies parlor, divided from the audience roon
by a brick wall. The restry, which is $30 \times 40$, can easily be oularged by opeuing the ground glass partitions between
thant and the ladies parlor, has a. enting capacity of 240 and vestry ontrances 8 y 12 , which provides threo ample and convemont spaces for ingress and egress Tho ladies parlor waiter from the kitchen and serving room below. The height
