The contents of this booklet consists of all the known Burial lots visited by Wilfred Osgood during the period of 1970 through 1983.

The names are listed alphabetically, followed by numbers and letters which refer to the map at the rear of this booklet. The map is divided across by numbers and down the sides by letters forming squares. Within each square each burial lot is numbered.

To locate the burial lots and stones of any given family, find the family name in the front index. Following each family name are numbers and letters referring to the map. For example, the Canney family has lots and stones in several locations. One of these, identified as 102, indicates that this particular lot is located in Section I, level C, #2 in the IC square.

In addition the Canney IC2 identification in the index refers to the page numbers on which more specific information may be found. The pages are arranged in alphabetical order, preceded by the number of the square.

Right of way to Private Graveyards

Any person wishing to have a temporary right of entry over private land in order to enter a private graveyard enclosure to which there is no public right of way, may apply in writing to the selectmen of a town, stating the reason for such a request and the period of time for which such right is to be excercised. Said applicant shall also notify in writing the owner or accupier of the land over which the right of way is desired. The selectmen may in the exercise of discretion, issue a permit for such temporary right of entry designating the particular place where said land may be crossed. The owner or occupier of said land may recommend said place of crossing which, if reasonable, shall be the place so designated by the selectmen or mayor.

Some of the entries for women list both the maiden name and the married name. In these cases, there are two entries. One lists the married name first, followed by the first name and the maiden name. (Smith, Betty Jones). The second lists the maiden name, followed by the married name, then the first name (Jones Smith, Betty). When a man is a Junior, the "Jr." is placed after his first name in order that the entry sorts with the last name, then the first name, rather than last name, then "Jr.", then first name. Dates are entered here in order to help differentiate between people with the same names. However, dates should be used from the volume, not from this index, to preclude errors on the transcriber's part.

If no date is listed in the reference volume, "????" is inserted in this index to indicate that the date was not left out as an oversight. In some cases an age is listed but one date either of birth or death is

was not left out as an oversight. In some cases an age is listed but one date, either of birth or death, is missing. In these cases, the missing date has been entered by adding or subtracting the age to the date listed. Such date listings are followed by the letter "e" for "estimated", to indicate that the date may be off by one year. In the event the age and one of the years is missing, the missing year is indicate by "????" since,

without an age, the missing date cannot be estimated.

Note: This index was created from a copy in the Rochester Public Library. Pages 26, 27, and 28 are missing from that copy. Hence, the entries thereon are not included in this index.
