


# Measuring Wellness: Patient Reported Outcomes at Bowdoin Street Health Center

## Introduction/Problem

- The Wellness Center at Bowdoin Street Health Center opened in May 2015
- The Wellness Center offers a range of physical and emotional health education and exercise classes for children, adults, and seniors.
- Measuring wellness entails capturing a range of definitions and health domains.
- A Patient Reported Outcomes approach offers a way to gather patients' experiences of Wellness.





# Aim/Goal

- Generate an interactive measurement tool that captures broad domains of wellness using validated measures.
- The measurement tool should be easy for patients to understand and complete.
- The tool provides a visual display of wellness scores over time that is viewable in the medical record.
- The tool can be integrated with clinical and utilization data.




## Interventions/Progress to Date

- Patient survey was developed with Harvard Catalyst to measure shared subjective outcomes
- Pending funding, we will implement a participation software tool to track access to participation data Fix EXFocility



- IS is building a PRO interface modeled after those used in other BIDMC departments.
- With analyst assistance we hope to eventually cross-link participation and subjective health to clinical and utilization outcomes (OMR, RedCap)
