Both Georgetown + Alexandria residents found the  
tolls high and upsetting and petitioned  
for a new bridge at Three Sisters Island.

1881 February 23, Congress authorizes purchase of  
Aqueduct Bridge. - \$125,000

### Anacostia River Bridges -

Fred Douglass  
1942 or before, authorized?  
built 1949, named F. Douglass Bridge  
in 1965.

11st Street Bridge - wrought iron  
1874 - authorized by Congress, ~~steel~~ truss  
replaced in 1908 and 1920

### John Philip Sousa Bridge

March 1815 - congressional act awards

\$20,000 in damage for burning of bridge  
by the British in 1814.

Renamed in 1845 - E. Wash. Citizens Assoc lobbies
