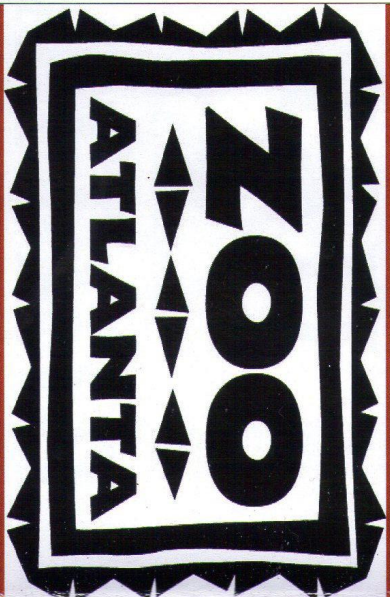
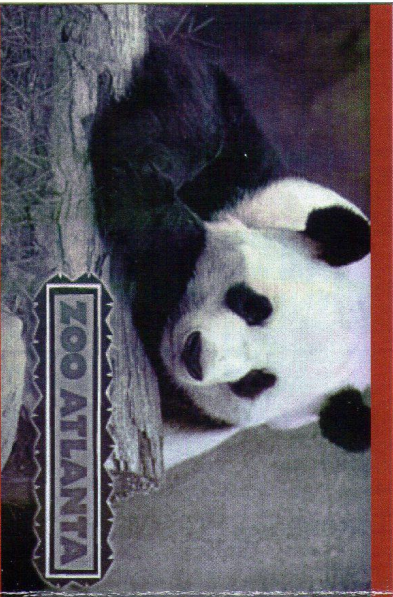
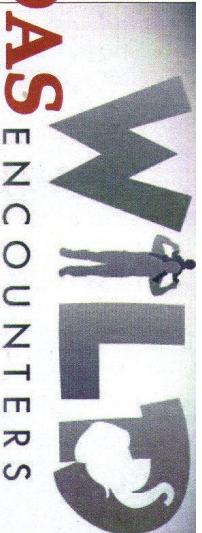
Celebrate with PANDAS

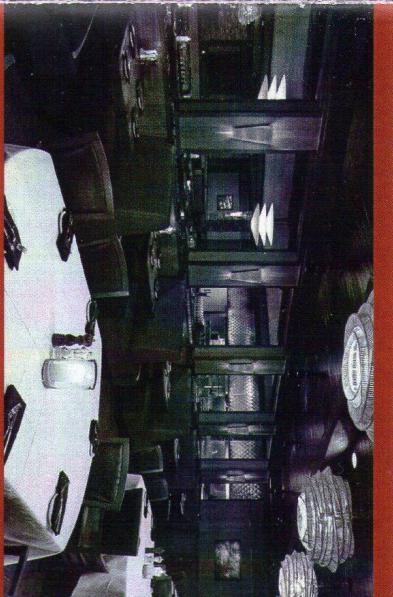
DID YOU KNOW?

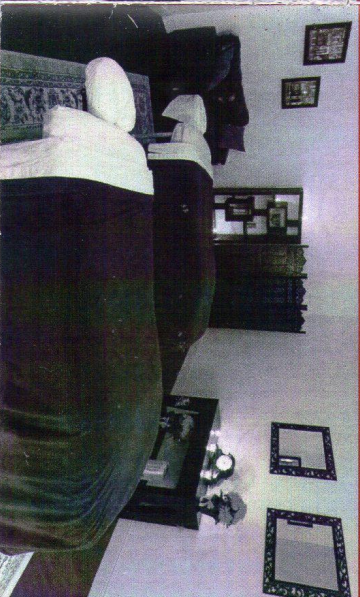

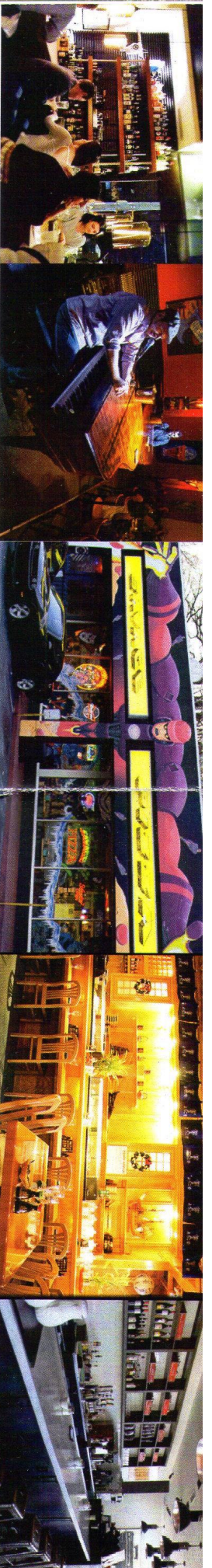
PAMPER yourself

THAICOON & SUSHI BAR

Thaicoon has a sushi bar and a Pad Thai that many online reviewers rave about. *Nerocomer Magazine* says it is a great date night spot.

HOMEGROWN

Homegrown has simple, comforting Southern Food. *Atlanta Magazine* says Homegrown’s “trademark comfy biscuit [is] a messy, chaotic jumble of fried chicken and sausage gravy, garnished with an ironically thin orange slice.”

SAVAGE PIZZA

Insite Atlanta writes, “At Savage, the pizzas and prepared dishes are made from scratch every day using homemade sauces, the best mozzarella, and fresh dough. In fact all the recipes use only freshest vegetables, finest quality meats, cheeses, breads and pastas.” This pizza joint also has a fun atmosphere full of super heroes.

FOX BROS. BBQ

This BBQ joint has delicious food! *Atlanta Magazine* says that “though their menu weaves in porkier Southern influences, beef is king here; go for the brisket, or show up early on Saturday (and often Tuesday) for the city’s finest Flintstonian beef rib.”

RED SKY TAPAS & BAR

This tapas restaurant has good food at reasonable prices. They also have a dueling piano bar on weekends from 9:00 PM to midnight.

GRAND CENTRAL PIZZA

Grand Central Pizza & Pasta has pizza, pasta, subs, and calzones. *Insite Atlanta* says, “They have an open kitchen so you can check out your pizza as it comes out of the oven... The house pizza is the Cardiac Arrest (pepperoni, spicy sausage, meatballs, ham and extra cheese), which is every bit as good as it sounds.”

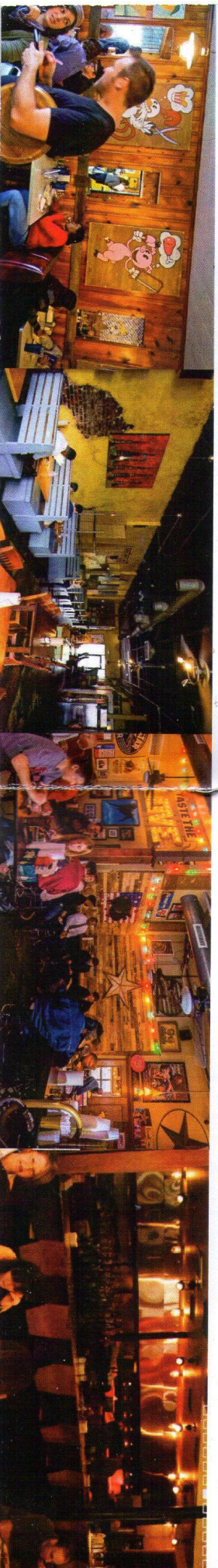
SOUTH CITY KITCHEN

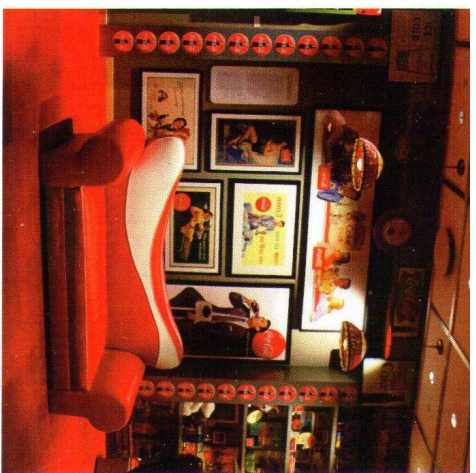

EXCELLENT EATS

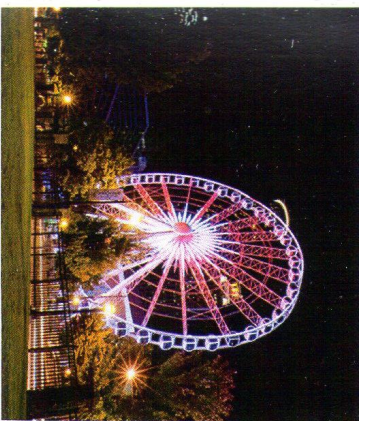




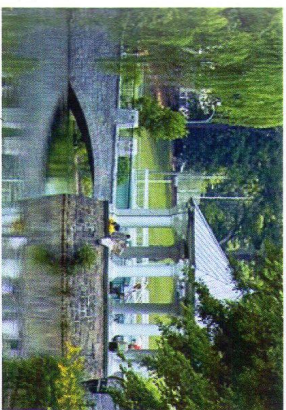

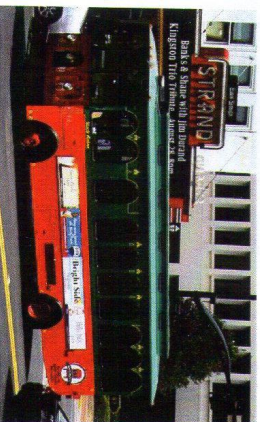


Piedmont Park covers 211 acres of parkland in the heart of metro Atlanta. Learn about the wildlife, plants, and history of the park with guide or self-directed tours. Take a walk around the Promenade, which features the Legacy Fountain and two grand meadows with stunning views of the new wetlands and woodlands. Enjoy a picnic in the Picnic Shelter - complete with tables and grills - or in the historic brick Bandstand.

Jackson Street Bridge is THE place to go in Atlanta to get the very best view of the Downtown Skyline. If you want to document your trip to the Atlanta, snap a selfie from the bridge. There you will be, with an amazing view of Downtown right behind your smiling face. 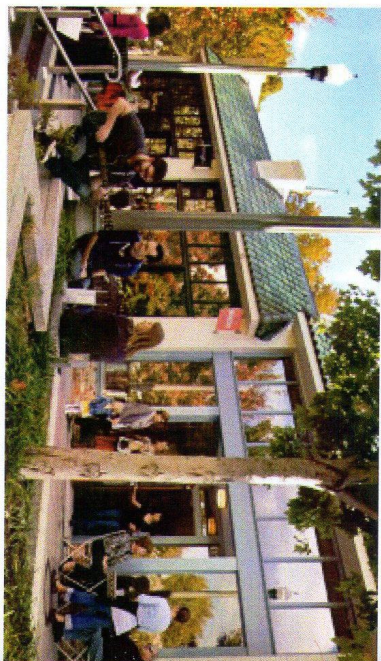


The Peachtree Trolley will provide 90 minute fully-narrated tours originating near Centennial Olympic Park and will introduce you to the "Must-Sees" of Atlanta. 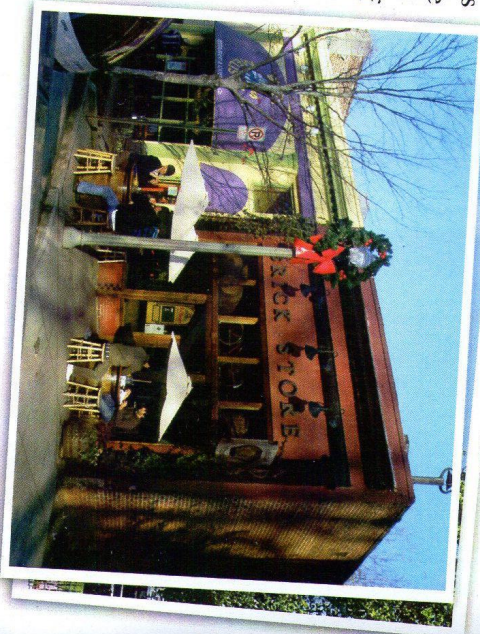
The **Smith Family Farm** features the Tullie Smith House, a plantation-plain house built in the 1840s by the Robert Smith family. The house and separate open-hearth kitchen are now surrounded by a dairy, blacksmith shop, smokehouse, double corncrib, slave cabin, and barn, as well as traditional vegetable, herb, field, flower, and slave gardens. The Smith Family Farm uses an open house format featuring first-person, costumed interpreters who initiate conversations that bring the history of our sites to life. Smith Family Farm visitors encounter characters portraying members of the Smith family, their neighbors, and enslaved workers who provide insight into the challenges of daily life on a rural Georgia farm during the Civil War.

DECATUR SQUARE

Decatur was established in 1823 where two Indian paths crossed at present-day Ponce de Leon and Clairmont avenues. Six miles outside of Atlanta, Decatur is a destination in itself for foodies, fashionistas and fun-lovers. They flock here for the city's critically acclaimed restaurants, musical venues like Eddie's Attic and Kavama, and storefront boutiques that specialize in the latest trends.

REVIVAL

Revival offers a proper version of the traditional Sunday dinner served family-style. Following the owner's allegiance to Southern cuisine, Revival focuses on farm-fresh ingredients and a dining experience that reflects the traditions his own family follows.

THE IBERIAN PIG

The Iberian Pig is a modern Spanish restaurant combining the tastes of Spain, with a fresh, eclectic, American social atmosphere. The focus of their menu is on traditional cured meats and Spanish cheese, tapas, salads and cocas (flatbreads).

CAKES & ALE RESTAURANT

Cakes & Ale Restaurant offers a may food variety ranging from Southern to Italian. They also have a cafe that offers sandwiches, soups, and desserts. It has been voted 50 Best Restaurants in Atlanta by *Atlanta Magazine*.

JAVA MONKEY

Java Monkey is a neat place to meet a friend for coffee, listen to musical and spoken performances, grab a quick snack, or have a glass of wine. It's quicky, collegey atmosphere matches its eclectic performances.

JENI'S ICE CREAM

Jeni's Ice Cream has ice cream, short-bet, frozen yogurt, sundaes, and ice cream cookie sandwiches. Their ice cream cookie sandwiches include Chocolate Hazelnut, Oatmeal Cream, Orchid Vanilla, and Salty Caramel with Smoked Almonds.

GREENE'S FINE FOODS

SUGAR MOON BAKE SHOP
