

AIDS ACTIVISTS DEMAND GET TISAH BACK ON TRACK!!

TISAH is the **Treatment Information System for AIDS and HIV**. **AIDS ACTION NOW!** proposed this treatment system last year: a comprehensive, state-of-the-art computer registry of treatments which could be accessed by PLWA/HIVs and their physicians in order to make effective health choices. After extensive lobbying and demonstrations by **AIDS ACTION NOW!** and the HIV community, Perrin Beatty adopted our idea of a treatment registry as the centrepiece of his **Federal AIDS Strategy**, announced in June 1990.

The Federal government contracted with the **University of Toronto** for the **Design Phase of TISAH**. The U. of T. has mismanaged TISAH and jeopardized confidence in a project which at one time was considered to have the potential to become an international landmark in AIDS/HIV treatment.

The future of TISAH will be decided on Wednesday, April 3, when the **Design Phase Advisory Committee** meets to review the **TISAH Management Committee's** workplan. **AIDS ACTION NOW!** needs you to show your support for an **activist vision of TISAH: a treatment registry which would be accessible, have community representation, would produce optimal standards of AIDS/HIV care across Canada, would support PLWA/HIVs and their physicians, and improve access to a wide range of effective treatments for AIDS/HIV.**
