Dear Friends and Colleagues,


I am writing this letter to you regarding an emergency situation that currently exists in our office. An African Nova Scotian man is suffering from AIDS and needs your help. His wife, who is currently in Zambia has very recently passed away from AIDS after a sudden attack from an opportunistic infection. His son, who is only eight years old is in Zambia alone. This man is in dire straits and desperately needs financial help. We are very much hoping that your organization could contribute to sending him to Zambia to get his son, and also to cement his wife's grave, for if this is not done then someone will be buried on top of her.

We have been able to get little bits of money here and there from the AIDS community but we are still about \$900.00 short. We are also hoping to get a discount for his ticket from the travel agency used by the Canadian AIDS Society.

This is a time when your support is very much needed. You will be helping one of our Brothers to save his son and his family the best way he can. Every little bit counts and would be greatly appreciated.
