**One Woman Who Smashed Guildhall
Window an American.**

LONDON, Nov. 10.—Alice Paul and Amelia Brown, the suffragists who gained access to the roof of the Guildhall last night and hurled stones through a stained-glass window while the Lord Mayor's banquet was in progress, were each sentenced to-day to one month at hard labor.

Both are members of Mrs. Emmeline Pankhurst's organization.
