I have a very rare piece consisting of an old wooden bowl and pounder used in grinding meal, similar to the picture enclosed, except that mine has a handle on the bowl to carry it by, such as I have marked with a pencil, hewn out of a log. Would you be interested in trading your Crow spear for this set? I have not fully decided whether or not I would trade as it is the only one I have ever had and it is quite old having been used in the early days, I do not know for sure whether I would let it go or not, but thought I would at least mention it, and I might decide to trade it for your spear. I have another hooped scalp, the only one I have left, the hoop being wrapped with red flannel, with large scalp in the center, would you want to consider this scalp pole for your spear? I have not fully made up my mind that I would part with it, but I might possibly do so after further thought, I just want to know whether or not you would want to consider either of these pieces, and I then would try and decide about it.
