In the British Columbia Baskets we have a good old Taltan Basket 7" high by about 8 1/2" diameter, painted with the heraldic design of the Frog price \$8.00.

We have some very fine specimens of old Fraser River Baskets, open and with covers, carrying and cooking forms.
