My Dear Sir


Your favour of the 30th last only reached us yesterday. The tribes you quote are mainly tribes from the West Coast of this Island all of whom do very similar work. There there is a variety of weaves Musselt. This is practically identical with the Haida.

No 1 Skidegate basket. We have an old Musselt basket from weave 11" high price 5<sup>00</sup>

No 2 We have a fine old small ~~coarse~~ Fort Wrangell basket 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " long 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " high 5" wide. with a coir price 5<sup>00</sup>

No 3 Nahwitt Indian. Narrow basket, open weave made from spruce strips top bound with cherry bark 12" long 7" high 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide has seen some service price 1.75

No 4 Greatstone Indian open weave slightly different

Wear to NOS and considerably frayed top bound with spruce root 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " high 9" long 7" wide slightly damaged price 1.50

✓ 5 Nootka Indian Open weave somewhat similar to weave no 4 but intersected by broad colored strips, length 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " width 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " height 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " price 2.00

6 "Kitsimat Indian Fine old cedar Bark Basket flat for holding Berry Spoons Panel design decoration with inner compartment, somewhat damaged through wear a very scarce shape and design price \$ 2.50

7 <sup>Kwakiutl</sup> ~~Boo~~ Island Indian, Delicately Basket made from fine bark colors very fine and pretty weave, zigzag colored decoration 15" long 5" width 6" high comparatively new price 1.75

8 Good specimen of the Fort Rupert Cedar Bark flexible Basket. Decoration Hongonat Black birds good weave 9" long 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " high price \$ 1.50 comparatively new
