Answering yours of the 25th I wish to state that it would be impossible for me to consider your collection of baskets as a whole, as I have represented in my own collection, all of the families or tribes mentioned, besides some more which increases in the basket line alone, fully 60 linguistic families.

I am, however, interested in the "Zuni" blanket and might be influenced to purchase it, provided you will do one of two things - either make me a lower price or else send me one of each of the Hava Supai Washoe and Digger Indian baskets, which I am willing to leave to your selection which would satisfy me as well as a lower price or a discount upon the price asked for the blanket.

I notice you have one "Death Valley". My understanding is the Death Valley Indians can be classed under the tribal name of "Panamint" of which I have a number of specimens.

Let me know at once in regard to this matter as I would like to dispose of the blanket business, by either keeping it and paying you for it or by returning it to you by return Express.
