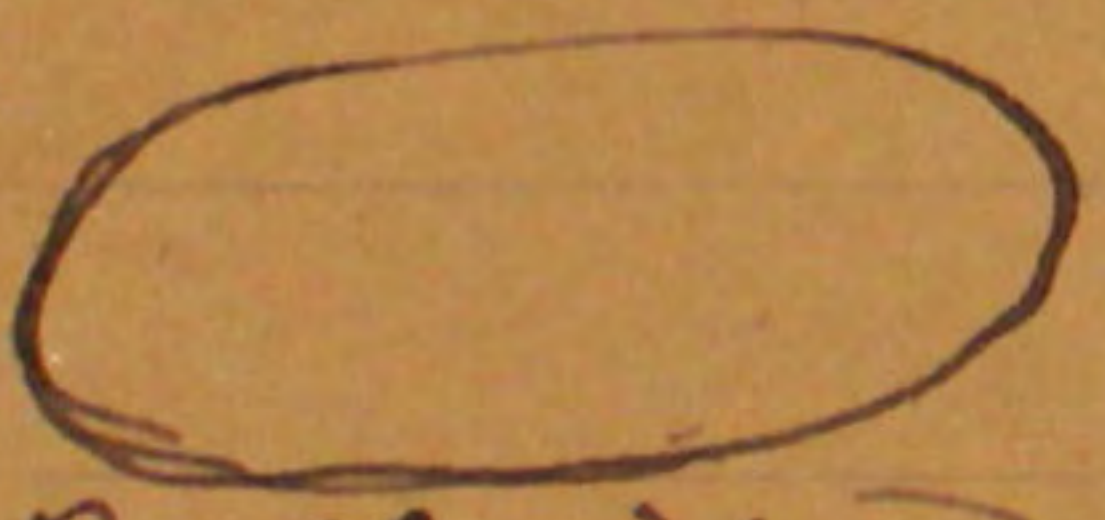

and of each article

The Large Mortar or corn grinder ^{width} 21 in
Long & 5 in high or thick, all of them are made of
Mal Pie Rock. ^{what} we call it in this Country

They are old ones, i just got 3 of them
in a few days ago as they are hard to get in
this Country. Well i have a better one in left
hand corner ^{of picture} with the Pestle of Pattery sitting on it. it
is 12 in wide & 20 in Long 4 high made in this shape



The smaller one with Pestle is not
very old like the other

The Chemal ^{in skin} with Eagle feathers is new one made of
Buckskin, that part you see the feathers are made of
Blue cloth like the indians always use. i will
mention some other things to you, i have a very

old 9 1/2 feet Long from tip to tip Lance Blade ^{10 in}
of Steel fastened with sinew in stick and Raped around
with Rawhide also, at the Lance pointing decorated with Buffalo
hair or skin & Eagle feathers ^{decorated with Buffalo skins with fur on} it is a fine one. i have a
Double headed Down ^{the} it is 19 in across the

side Painted mostly Yellow

and Blue Design on main Body of Drum ~~is~~
 and the other one is Double headed as some other
 one & some painting Not so large Made of Deer skin
 and has a fine tone 12 in high 15½ in across face of
 Drum, i also have one Tam Tam or Drum 15 in across
 face of Drum 6 in high Made of Deer skin rat so
 newy old but a good one, i have one old
 Spanish Bridle Bitt with ~~old~~ horse hair head
 Stall. it is the only one ^{like} i have seen in this
 Country for 38 years. the indians sent me
 only ^{one} 3 old Baskets. they are flat something like
 the ones i sent you ~~last~~ time But Older But rat
 in as ^{good} a shape as these if you want to send them i can
 i will ^{i never looked one} take \$6 for ^{the} 4 Baskets and for the mo. Tor. Tis. or
 the ^{Coon} Grinders the Large one you see in picture is \$6 the next Large
 one \$6 With ~~pepper~~ the smaller one is \$3
 the Chamal is \$4 the Lance for \$6⁵⁰ the Large Drum \$8

 on it take \$4 for out fit. i have an indian suit Made of Buckskin with
 Bead work on it Will take \$35⁰⁰ for it. it Will fit ~~up~~ any one wearing No
 18 1/2 size suit. i have other things But rat newy old ones as they are
 hard to get. So i just thought i mention the other things
 as you might be interested in some of them yours
