

The Large Mortar & Or corn grinder 12 in width 21 in
long & 5 in high or thick. all of them are made of
^{white} Maf Piz Rock. what we call it in this Country
they are Old ones, i just got 3 of them
in a few days ago as they are hard to get in
this Country. Well i have a better one in left
hand Lower ^{part of picture} corner with the Peas of Pottory sitting on it. it
is 12 in wide & 20 in long 4 high made in this shape

 the smaller one with Pestle is not
very old like the others

The ^{Pueblo Indian} Cheman with Eagle Feathers is new one made of
Buckskin, that part you see the feathers on is made of
Blue Cloth like the Indians always use. i Will
mention some other things to you, i have ^{long} Lance not very
old 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet long from tip to tip Lance Blade 10 in
of Steel fastened with sinew in stick and wrapped around
with Raw hide also at the Lance forging decorated with Buffalo
hair or skin & Eagle feathers it is a thin one. i have one
double headed down the face & 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ in high
the other one ha

one End an Indian on
side Painted with Yellow

and Blue Design on main Body of Drums &
 and the other one is Double headed as said other
 one & same Painting but so Large made of Deer skin
 and has a fine time 12 in high $15\frac{1}{2}$ in across face of
 Drum. i also have one Tam Tam or Drum 15 in across
 face of Drum 8 in high made of Deer skin not so
 very old but a good one. i have one old
 Spanish Bridle Bit With good horse hair head
 stall. it is the only one ^{like} i have seen in this
 country for 38 years. the Indians sent me
 only ^{out} 8 old Baskets. they are flat something like
 the ones i sent you last time but older but not
 in as ^{good} shape as those if you want to send them i can
^{i am looking for}
^{the Com} i will take \$8 for 4 Baskets and for the m. t. t. or
 Grinders the ^{one} you see in Picture is \$6 the next large
 one \$8 with Peeler the smaller one is \$3
 the Chisel is \$4 the Lance for \$8 the Large Drum \$8
 the smaller one \$5 the single head drum \$3 the Bridle Bit & head stall
for \$4 I have 4 arons & spines to hold same made of Wolf skin with one
 mit take \$4 for ant fit. i have an Indian suit made of Buckskin with
 Bead Work on it Will take $35\frac{00}{00}$ for it. it will fit ~~any~~ any one wearing no
 13 size suit. i have other things but not very old ones as they are
 hard to get. So i just thought i ~~will~~ mention the other things
 as you might be interested in some of them Yours s
