

they may have some made like Saddle Baggs But i never
noticed any of that kind or ever heard of any one

i tell you what i have seen. i seen the Navajo
Indians have something like what you mention
made of Willow sticks. the size of your little finger or very
coarse work. they were using them to carry groats
in when going to market on Burros or horses & mules
and will try & get one of these also
