Gentlemen:

MAYOR'S OFFICE

has been kept out of school under my supervision and guidance.

In our telephone conversation on September 23, I stated to you the following incidents:

On Tuesday, September 17, but bus was stoned.

On Wednesday, September 18, some boys were using racial epithets on the M.B.T.A. bus; and the driver, who was black, stopped the bus and threatened that all of the boys would be put off the bus in Roxbury.

On Thursday, September 19, was riding on a bus in which all the windows were broken from previous stonings. As you know, bus is not protected by the police because the school is not under the forced busing plan.

Recently my daughter was a victim of violence on the streets in which she was attacked by a black man, and after stealing her purse and inflicting bodily injury, he then ran over her leg and caused a compound fracture which required an operation to put a screw in her ankle. This incident is causing my daughter to be out of work for at least three months. Of course, I have not even mentioned the mental anguish and suffering this entire incident has placed on my daughter, and therefore causes me to feel that I cannot cope with anymore at this point.

I am deeply concerned for my son's safety and

will protect him to the best of my ability. If I feel his safety is threatend again, I will have to take further action.

I would appreciate stachers giving him extra homework in order to catch up on what he missed, but under NO CIRCUMSTANCES do I want him to stay after school. I want him to leave the school with the rest of the boys because I do not want him in Roxbury alone.

If there are any questions, please feel free to call. I will be glad to clarify my situation if necessary.
