On the 7th day of November, A. D. 1955, appeared the plaintiffs in person and by their attorneys of record, and also appeared the defendants in person and by their attorneys of record, and the motion of defendants to dismiss the cause of action and abate the suit was considered by the Court on a joint trial of plaintiffs' plea for a temporary injunction and for a permanent injunction on the merits. At plaintiffs' request the case was heard and determined not only on the plea for temporary injunction but also for permanent injunction on the merits.
