CU joins OU board of regents

Gov. David Walters on May 28 signed legislation transferring Cameron University from the Board of Regents for Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical Colleges and placing it under the board that governs the University of Oklahoma.

Walters did the ceremonial signing on stage at University Theater before a standing room only audience of approximately 500. He and his wife, Rhonda, flew by helicopter to Lawton despite a busy schedule on the next-to-last day of the legislative session.

The state legislature on May 21 passed the legislation. The new alliance becomes effective June 1.

Walters said he was signing the bill in memory of the late Dr. Vic Williams, OU regent from Lawton whose dream was to unite the schools under the same board. Williams died recently in an accident.

Walters said of Williams, "I know he is here with us on stage in spirit." He asked Cheryn Williams, the widow of the late regent, to join him at the desk when he signed the bill.

Both CU President Don Davis and OU President Richard Van Horn expressed elation.

"We know it is a good fit. We are proud to be a partner," Davis said.

Van Horn said:

"We are pleased and delighted that OU and Cameron can have this new partnership."

Davis said that advantages of the academic marriage include mutual ties in research and in the fields of law, technology, business, and health care education. The University of Oklahoma includes the Norman campus and the health sciences center in Oklahoma. Cameron's strong pre-med, pre-pharmacy, and nursing programs will benefit, Davis said.

Van Horn said he hopes to move soon to help Cameron develop a masters program in nursing. He predicted faculty exchanges and joint activities at Fort Sill, where both schools are already offering courses. He also predicted joint activities in Southwest Oklahoma in fine arts, science, and research.

Davis said the agricultural program will remain strong at Cameron, and that there will be no name change.


"This will always be Cameron as far as I'm concerned," he said. He added that Cameron, since it was founded in 1908 as Cameron State School of Agriculture, has always changed to meet the changing needs of Southwest Oklahoma.

Today the student body is a diverse ethnic mix, and many students have jobs in the work force. Cameron, with its Outreach programs, flexible class schedules, Business Research Center, Fire Support Models and Simulations Institute, and fully automated library, has been on the cutting edge of educational innovation in Oklahoma.

The original move to make the change in regents was initiated by Rep. Sid Hudson, D-Lawton; Rep. Jim Glover, D-Elgin; and Rep. Loyd Benson, D-Frederick. Glover is House speaker pro tem and Benson is the majority floor leader.

The bill was authored by Rep. Don McCorkell, D-Tulsa, and Sen. Penny Williams, D-Tulsa.

CU wins Lone Star golf, baseball titles

Cameron's 1991-1992 golf and baseball teams won Lone Star Conference championships, and walked away with a number of individual conference honors.

Five golfers and six baseball players were recognized on all-conference teams. The baseball team dominated the all-LSC squad with six of the 15 players, as well as Player, Coach. and Player of the Year honors.

Jerry Hrnciar's perennially powerful golfers ran away with a 17-stroke victory at the LSC Tournament played April 22 at the Trophy Club in Roanoke, Texas. It was CU's third conference golf title in four years of LSC competition.

Hrnciar said:

"I knew this team had talent all year. We were just slow getting started. John Glenn and Dustin Wigington sealed it for us. They were the first ones in on the last day and posted a 72 and a 74. Once I saw their scores I knew there wasn't anyone who could catch us."

The baseball team, under ninth-year

coach Ron Ihler, swept a three-game series from Abilene Christian at McCord Field on May 1-2 to win the LSC title. LSC schools participating in baseball include Abilene Christian, Central Oklahoma, and Eastern New Mexico.

Ihler said the single game May 1 was the big one. With pitching ace Dennis Milius on the mound, the Aggies held on for an 8-5 win. They won the title with a 5-3 decision in the next day's opener and completed the sweep with a 6-1 victory.

The golfers began the spring nationally ranked but stumbled somewhat, failing to finish ahead of ACU in two other times before the LSC tourney.

The baseball team spent two weeks in the national rankings early in the season but dropped a three-game series at ACU in late March. But the team won 10 of its last 12 LSC games, including the season-ending series. The LSC champion does not earn an automatic playoff bid in either sport, and both Cameron teams fell short of bids to


national playoffs.

Individual honors included:

Senior Tres Newton, sophomore Mike O'Connell, and freshman Ross Parmley finished in the top five at the LSC tournament to earn first team alleague honors. Senior David Stewart and junior John Glenn earned second-team with top 10 finishes. Newton was invited to compete as a medalist at the NCAA Division II championships in Spartanburg, S.C.

Baseball junior catcher Tyler Williams, who led the league with 17 home runs and 52 RBI, was named LSC Player of the Year. Junior left-hander Dennis Milius, who led the league in wins with 10 was Pitcher of the Year. Ron Ihler was named Coach of the Year.

Others selected on the conference baseball first team were Chris DeClerck, senior first baseman; T.J. Gusso, freshman second baseman; Diego Hernandez, senior shortstop, and Eagle Fixico, senior outfielder. Milius and Williams were first-team selection on the All-South Central region team.


