World Building- The process of constructing an imaginary world, sometimes associated with a whole fictional universe

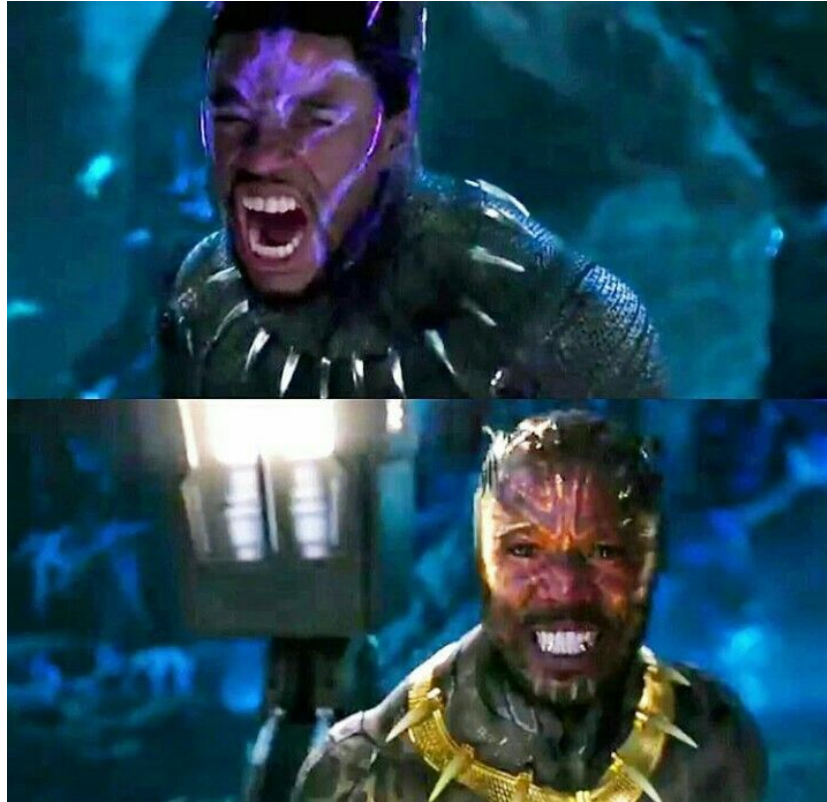
Division between African American and African- The relationship between African Americans in the USA attempting to connect with their ancestral homeland
