ACTS OF AGGRESSION

Protest by League of Nations Union

At a meeting of the Hobart branch of the League of Nations Union last night the following motion was agreed to:

This meeting protests against the acts of aggression committed by Japan in China, and the brutal slaughter of Chinese civilians, and urges the Commonwealth Govern-

ment to take a lead in invoking the machinery of the League of Nations to find a way to terminate the conflict by collective action with other Powers.

A telegram received from the national secretary of the Union advised that a meeting of the Federal Council was about to be held in Sydney to discuss important matters, including the question of a boycott.

It was decided that the Sydney representative of the Tasmanian section of the Union be given a free hand at the Council meeting, and that he be informed that the Tasmanian executive was in favour of the strongest steps possible being taken to end aggression.
