RARE CONTINENTAL PORCELAIN SPECIMENS-Photot #155.

1. Meissen coffee pot, all white, with masked spout and cover. Beautiful early Meissen paste of the finest quality. 6" high. Blue crossed swords mark. About 1730-35. Small Small break at end of handle, minor chips on ends of finial leaves and small chip on edge of lid....no repairs. See Honey's "Dresden Porcelain" Pl.#31 for same shape. Rare. \$100.00
2. Rare Buen Retiro bust of a cavalier on a pedestal; 4-1/4" high. Beautiful colors: lavender coat and a white waist-coat and black hat. About 1770. Small break at end of black ribbon on hat; not noticeable. \$100.00
3. Large Meissen plate with Golden Lion pattern and dec. w. numerous sprays and sprigs of flowers in lovely coloring. 10" in dia. Blue crossed swords mark. About 1740. Some rubbing on outer gilt edge which adds to the charm of the specimen. Small birds and insects on the outer edge of plate. See Ostermann "Sammlung Porzellane" Pl.8-#153. \$50.00
4. Vienna (Du Paquier period) tall double handled cup, about 1730. 3-1/4" high. Decorated with strewn "German Flowers" in lovely early coloring, typical of Vienna. See Wiener Porzellan Sammlung "Karl Mayer" #31 for similar decoration. Rare. \$90.00
5. Small bust of "Winter"---Frankenthal; model by Konrad Linck. About 1765. 2-3/4" high. Winter has a grey beard; the drapery is painted with small blue flowers. Very fine porcelain and modelling. Mark is "CT" with a crown above in blue, and AB in blue below; also the initials "GMM" in red. Illus. in Hofmann's "Frankenthaler Porzellan". Rare. Similar models are illustrated in Schmidt's "Porcelain". \$100.00
6. Buen Retiro all white c/s is SOLD.
7. Weesp mustard pot is SOLD.
8. Marieberg c/s is SOLD.
9. Meissen teapot and cover in melon shape, taken from the Chinese, with colorful flowering vines in rather strong relief, and beautiful Oriental coloring. Cover has a twig handle is charmingly decorated. Rare and unusual specimen. Blue crossed swords mark. About 1730. \$225.00
10. Meissen small mug beautifully dec. w/ colorful Oriental flowers and fret-work border; in iron red, puce, yellow and green. 3-1/4" high. Bold blue crossed swords mark. Mint. \$75.00
