1. A Bow tea bowl and saucer painted with chrysanthemums and Oriental flowers. Fine thin porcelain. Excellent condition. About 1755. \$55.00
2. A fine Chantilly saucer dish painted with banded hedge and Kakiemon flowers. 4-3/4" in dia. Brown edge. The early tin glaze period, about 1735. Perfect. \$62.50
3. A rare Japanese bottle painted with two gazelles, one yellow and one light blue, and a flowering tree. Arita. Kakiemon style. A beautifully shaped bottle. 8" high. Late 17th century. Perfect. \$225.00
4. A Japanese bowl painted with bird cage and birds in flowering shrubs. Arita. Kakiemon style. Brown edge. Late 17th century. Perfect. 4-1/2" in dia. \$65.00
5. A Chelsea leaf dish painted with the yellow running rat and flying fox pattern. 8" long. Perfect. Some kiln crazing. Dates probably just before the red anchor period or earlier. No mark. \$125.00
6. A Bow sauceboat painted with large vari-colored chrysanthemums in raised enamel colors---"Famille rose style". 7" long. About 1755. Perfect. \$125.00
