18th CENTURY PORCELAIN SPECIMENS-ENGLISH & CONTINENTAL

This list consists chiefly of single specimen cups which make fine study items.

1. Derby Leaf shaped Sauce Boat beautifully dec. w. sprays of flowers, painted in a delicate shade of puce and slight gilding. The ornament at twig handle is sharply modelled with May flowers and leaves. 7-1/2" long. Mint. Fascinating soft, waxy paste, greenish in tone and quite transparent. About 1755-60. \$65.00
2. Tall Cap Di Monte cup dec. w. raised allegorical scenes painted in beautiful colors. About 1765. Small chip repair at rim. \$15.00
3. Unusual tall cup with a flat handle painted with flowering plants. 3" high. Factory is undetermined. Pictured in E.C.C. Vol. 1, Tr.3, 1935, pl.VIII. Rim chip. \$22.50
4. Hennevy Honey Jar dec. w. large colorful sprays of flowers. Very fine, soft, unctuous paste. 5-1/2" high. Even though the cover is badly damaged, this is still a desirable collector's item---as the paste and the decoration are very fine. About 1750. Incised D.V. mark. \$110.00
5. Vienna small mug beautifully painted with colorful sprays of flowers. Mint condition. 2-3/4" high. Blue bee-hive mark. About 1760. \$27.50
6. Hennevy creampot and cover beautifully dec. w. sprays of flowers. May be crepy-en-Valois. Mark, "D'OTP" incised in paste. See Honey's "French Porcelain", pl.41. 3-5/8" high. Good condition; minor break at end of handle. \$37.50
7. Lowdin's Bristol or early Worcester Sauce Boat in the form of over-lapping leaves, the edges of which are painted with a delicate shade of reddish-pink. Scattered insects painted on body and a delightful pale blue morning-glory in the inside of boat on bottom. 7-1/4" long. About 1755. \$65.00
- 8.&9. Two Liverpool cups with handles. These are specimen cups and their origin as to factory is controversial. About 1765. Mint. \$22.50 ea.
10. Pr. of Dr. Wall Worcester coffee cup dec. w. scenes depicting Roman ruins. The scenes are printed in black and filled in with color. About 1770. Fine quality porcelain. \$17.50 ea.
11. Tall Liverpool cup dec. w. sprays and sprigs of flowers in the Oriental style in famille-rose enamel colors/ Lovely decoration. Cup has handle. 2-5/8" high. Mint. \$27.50
12. Dr. Wall Worcester teacup painted in colors and with gilding. A radiating pattern of three red up-rights bound with a gold band; festoons of leaves and red berries between uprights. Bleu-de-roi border. Minor age crack at rim. \$15.00
13. Very fine Liverpool tall cup with straw handle dec. w. a scene depicting a lady sitting in a pastoral landscape. Exquisite painting in lovely colors. A rare study item. About 1765. \$25.00
14. Liverpool coffee cup similar to #11. \$22.50
