RARE 18th CENTURY ENGLISH PORCELAIN- DR. WALL WORCESTER,
 BOW, CHELSEA, LONGTON HALL and LIVERPOOL. Photo #142.

1. Bow teacup dec. w. a large peony and butterfly in the Oriental style. Fine early paste, about 1750-55. Mint. \$17.50
2. Derby plate beautifully dec. w. exotic birds in shrubbery. 8-1/4" in dia. Also dec. w. the arms of "Lovett". Apparently a replacement made for a Lowestoft plate; at any rate, done in the Oriental manner. Mint. Has a collector's sticker. About 1760. \$65.00
3. Chelsea-Derby creampot and cover dec. w. fruit, flowers and butterflies in lovely coloring. Mint. Gold anchor and interwoven "D" mark. About 1775. \$35.00
4. Dr. Wall Worcester wavy edge plate dec. w. colorful sprays of flowers; 8-1/2" dia. About 1770. \$25.00
5. Chelsea teapot and cover dec. w. sprays and sprigs of flowers. About 1760. \$60.00
6. Pair of early Liverpool cups dec. w. a crest and figures in landscape. The bottom of the inside of the cup is painted with a large colorful rose. A fine specimen of early Liverpool with the tin glaze. About 1765. Mint. \$25.00 ea.
7. Pair of Dr. Wall Worcester cups with handles, dec. with Roman scenes. The decoration is outlined in a delicate black line and then the colors are applied. About 1770. \$20.00 ea.
8. Chelsea plate dec. w. sprays and sprigs of colorful flowers; 8-3/4" in dia. Shows some wear on glaze. Red anchor mark. \$40.00
9. Dr. Wall Worcester c/s dec. w. sprays of flowers in varying shades of a beautiful green color. Cup is mint. Saucer, which is not pictured, was repaired years ago with rivets. A very rare pattern. Crossed swords mark with the numeral "9". About 1765. \$50.00
10. Dr. Wall Worcester saucer with scale blue ground and with mirror and vase shaped panels, framed in gilt rococo borders, and painted with vari-colored flowers. Blue square mark. About 1765. \$25.00
11. Dr. Wall Worcester single cup dec. w. hog-standard pattern; the upper and lower edges are "bleu de roi". Has an age crack about 1" long. \$15.00
12. Dr. Wall Worcester c/s in blue and white. The body of cup and saucer are moulded. Chinese "character" mark. About 1760. Mint. \$25.00
13. Chelsea plate is SOLD.
14. Longton Hall teacup and saucer dec. w. naturalistic flowers in beautiful colors. Mint. About 1755. \$45.00
15. Pair of Caughley blue and white c/s dec. w. the pheasant pattern. Hatched crescent marks. About 1775. See Fisher's "Blue and White English Porcelain". \$20.00 ea.

16. Dr. Wall Worcester single saucer dec. in underglaze blue and enamel colors with gilding. Dark blue ground with large exotic bird in colors. Blue square fret mark. About 1770. See Lloyd, Pl. 65- 296. \$35.00
17. Dr. Wall Worcester single cup with handle; with scale blue ground with mirror and vase shaped panels, framed in gilt rococo borders, and painted in colors and gold with a large exotic bird on each side of cup. Blue square mark. About 1770. Mint. \$25.00
