Dear Mr. Stoughton,

Thank you so much for your kind letter to me. I imagine a statement was sent to our home on Staten Island, which was not forwarded to me. I shall mail you what is due as soon as we are paid again, when that will be I don't know, as we are being moved around so much from one unit to another.

I have now been transferred to the Graduate Camp. Am living in a tent and eating from a mess kit. And enjoying it very much. In a short while I expect to know whether or not I've been accepted for Officers School or not. I shall keep you posted as to changes in address etc.

Attending church one Sunday I found that the Chaplain was a Wagner Alumnus. Reverend Edmund

Bosch of the floor of 1922, I believe. We
have had some interesting conversation
since making each others acquaint-
ance, and I've been much benefited
by his services. He is a very spir-
itual and live person, who is
keenly aware of his responsibilities to
his men. I am enclosing a copy
