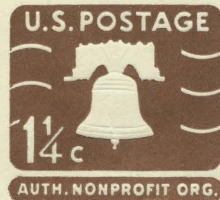
Our attendance last year was wonderful. Let us make this year's service bigger and better.

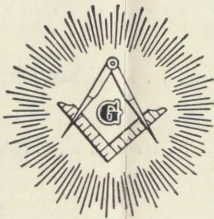
