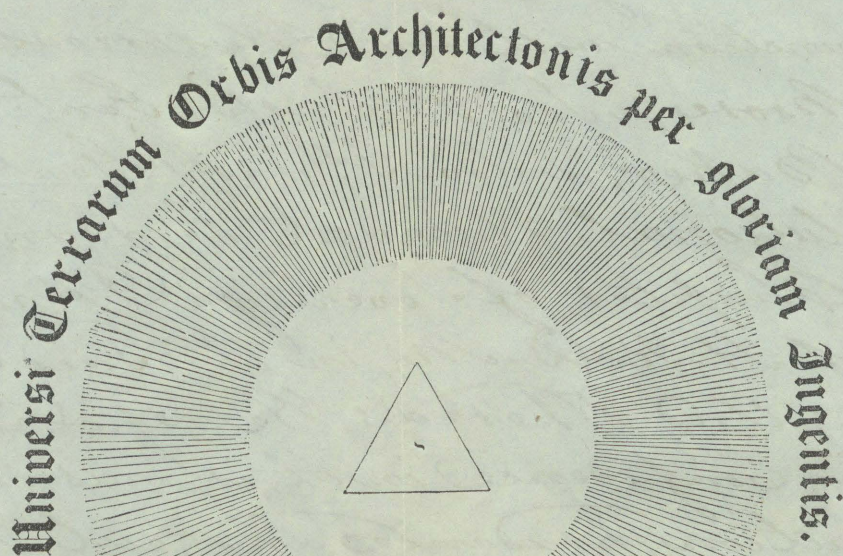

To our Illustrious, most Valiant and Sublime Princes of the Royal Secret, Knights of K—H, Illustrious Princes and Knights, Grand, Ineffable and Sublime, Free and Accepted Masons of all degrees, ancient and modern, over the surface of the two Hemispheres:

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE LETTERS MAY COME, GREETING:

Health, — Stability, — Power.

Know Ye, That we the undersigned, Most Puissant Sovereigns, Grand Inspectors General, lawfully and constitutionally established at our **GRAND EAST**—the City of New-York, in Supreme Council of the thirty-third degree, for the Northern Masonic district and jurisdiction of the United States of North America, and duly congregated this — *20th* — day of *Sivan* A. H^m. *5005*. A. LIB^s. *2381* — which corresponds to the — *25th* — day of *June 1845* — of the Christian Era, and A. O^s. *727*. — and A. M^m. *531* — at our Grand Council Chamber, a SACRED ASYLUM, where reign

Praying that as Original Founders in the City of Boston
and in Conjunction with our Illustrious Brothers -
Chas H. Moore, a Sov. G^d Insp^r Gen^l of the 33^d -
& Ruel Baker, a Sov. G^d Insp^r Gen^l of the 33^d -
a Constitutional Warrant be granted them to
hold a Chapter of Sovereign Princes Rose
Croix of H-R-D-M, in the said City of
Boston; And Whereas We repose especial
trust and Confidence in their masonic knowledge,
circumspection, prudence and zeal, We hereby
grant them the object of their wishes, investing
them with full power and authority - to form
organize and establish themselves at the
said City of Boston, State of Massachusetts -
as a "Chapter of Sovereign Princes Rose
Croix of H-R-D-M", with ample power and
authority to our said Illustrious Brothers and
their legal Successors to assemble constitu-
=nally, Elect, Install their Officers, also
Initiate, exalt and perfect according to
the old standing Rules and Regulations
and Subject also to the Grand Constitu-
=tions of the thirty third degree promul-
=gated at the City of Berlin, in Prussia
on the first day of May A. D. 1786. -
Only qualified Brethren, Members of
their Grand Council Princes of Jerusalem
unto the Sublime Degrees of Knights
of the East and West, and of Sovereign
Prince Rose Croix of H-R-D-M.
In testimony whereof so that full
faith and credit may be given to all
their lawful acts and deeds, We have
delivered them this our Dispensation
to have full force and effect until

a "Regular & correct of Constitutions"
 can be prepared and delivered them
 in its place and stead, & Have hereunder
 subscribed our respective signatures
 and caused hereunto to be affixed the Stamp
 and Seals of our Illustrious Order.
 at the date and place above named.
