

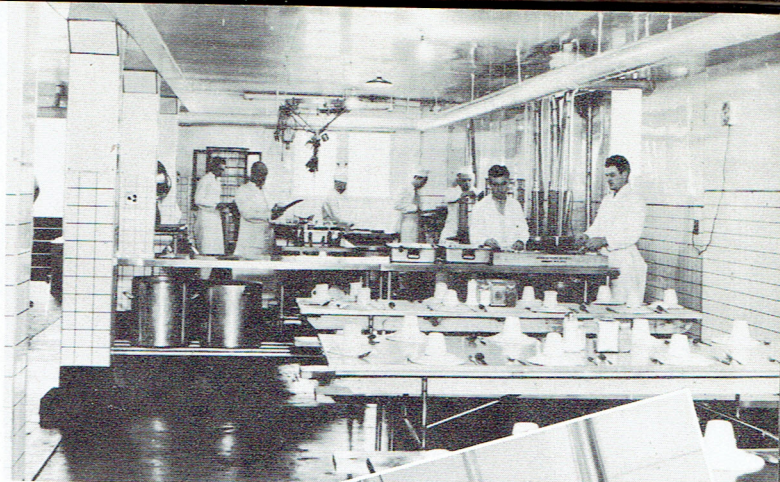
# Cooks' and Bakers' School

The District Cooks' and Bakers' School is located at District Headquarters in Omaha, Nebraska. All of the camp mess stewards and first cooks have completed the course.

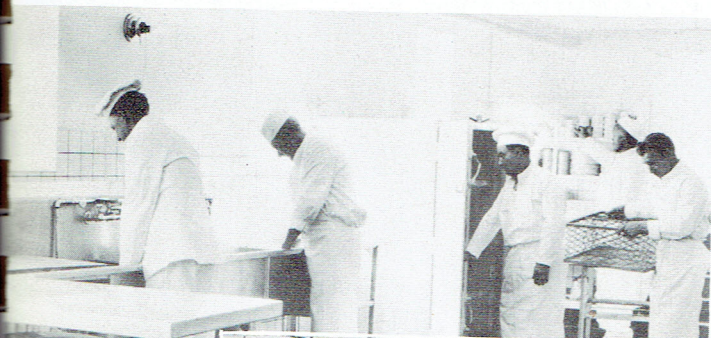
Instruction is given in cooking, baking, mess management, and dietetics. The mess stewards' course lasts one month and the cooking and baking instruction covers two months. Trips are made to a nearby packing plant, baking and commission house. Films on nutrition and other allied subjects are used in connection with classroom work.

The School was started on an experimental basis in June, 1939. The successful achievements have resulted in the School now being established on a permanent basis.

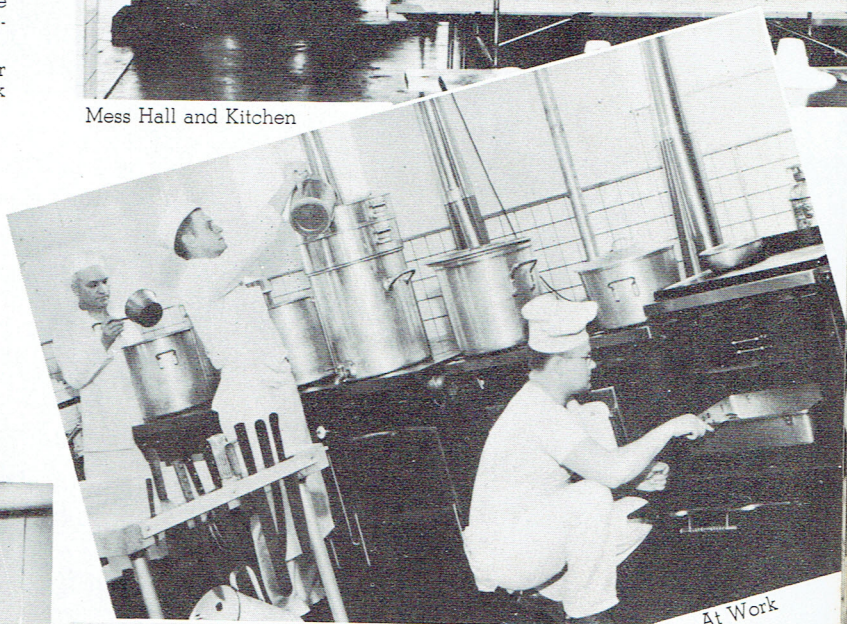
Classes for company commanders and mess officers are planned for the near future. Each subaltern upon entering on duty spends one week at the School before going to duty in a camp.



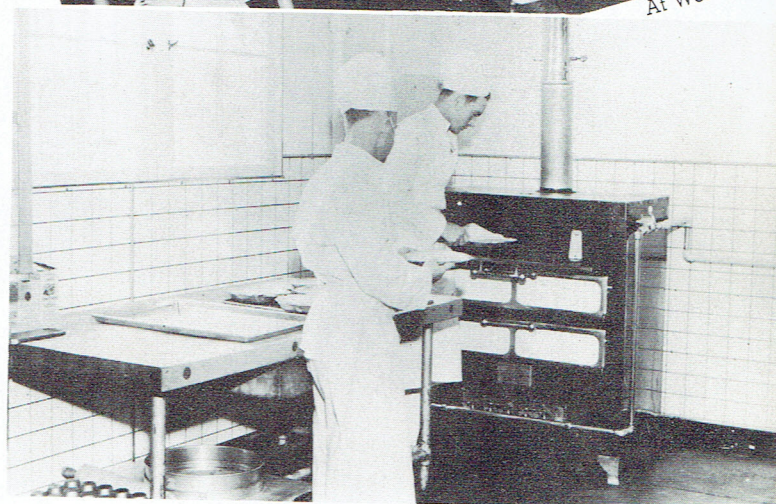
Mess Hall and Kitchen
