

property, which is invested in Wm Fawcett, & Richard Alderson as the donors they are the persons who probably should appoint but as the Minister for the time being is the person solely interested in the House and Land, his wishes in the choice should be as such consulted, while the views of the congregation should also be considered in respect of their interest in the Chapel itself.

So you would appoint the Trustees of the School-room and Institute in concert with the desire of your people and the choice should be agreeable to all parties interested, and should be of the same persons for both sets of purposes.

I do not know ^{whether} the persons proposed to be ~~admitted~~ appointed do in each or any instance meet with the approbation of yourself and Congregation or of either, If they are agreeable to all, well and good, If not I would suggest that all parties should meet and endeavour to agree upon a number of Trustees, acceptable and this letter which you can read to the meeting may conduce to this result.

If any change in the proposed Trustees should be necessary I shall be very happy to facilitate it by preparing the necessary new power of attorney free of expense.

I shall be most glad to give you any further information and to do every thing in my power to promote the well being and harmony of a people in whom I feel much interest, and I remain
