

of Thwaité or other persons appointed by the said Church to receive all moneys paid for sittings in the said Chapel at Thwaité or in any way contributed for the benefit and when the said Chapels shall be separated and the duties thereof performed by separate Ministers or Pastors then by the deacons of the said Church at Thwaité and after payment thereof of the interest of any money which may be borrowed on mortgage of the said premises at Thwaité or on the personal security of the said Church or the Chapel thereat the repairs and adequate insurance of the said Chapel and any other equally necessary incidental expenses for the fit and proper performance of Divine Worship to apply the remainder in payment of the Ministers or Pastors for the time being officiating in and upon trust with the written consent of a majority of the said Trustees under the direction of two thirds of the male and female members of the said Church being communicants as aforesaid voting at a special meeting convened as hereinafter provided to let on lease or otherwise to mortgage sell or exchange the said premises to be taken in exchange to be situated within half a mile of the said village of Thwaité and to be held upon the trusts hereby declared and to apply the moneys change after paying all costs and expenses in or towards the enlargement rebuilding improvement or repairs of the said premises or in the purchase of other premises of the said trust premises as shall be directed by a vote of two thirds of the said members approved by the said seatholders as aforesaid. And upon further trust that the said premises shall be dispersed or if the public worship of God as aforesaid in the said premises shall be discontinued for two years together said moneys in such manner and for such religious purposes not tending to the promulgation of doctrines inconsistent with those adopted in or as shall be directed by the Ministers or Pastors or a majority of them of such seven Congregational Baptist Churches as shall then be nearest and declared that no Minister or Pastor shall be disqualified from or prevented by the said trustees officiating as such in the said Chapel at Thwaité unless and until or of holding or maintaining preaching or inculcating doctrines not in accordance with or not conforming to the discipline of the said Congregational Union of England for the purpose of hearing and adjudicating upon such charge brought against such Minister or Pastor to be convened as hereinafter provided unless such charge shall while
