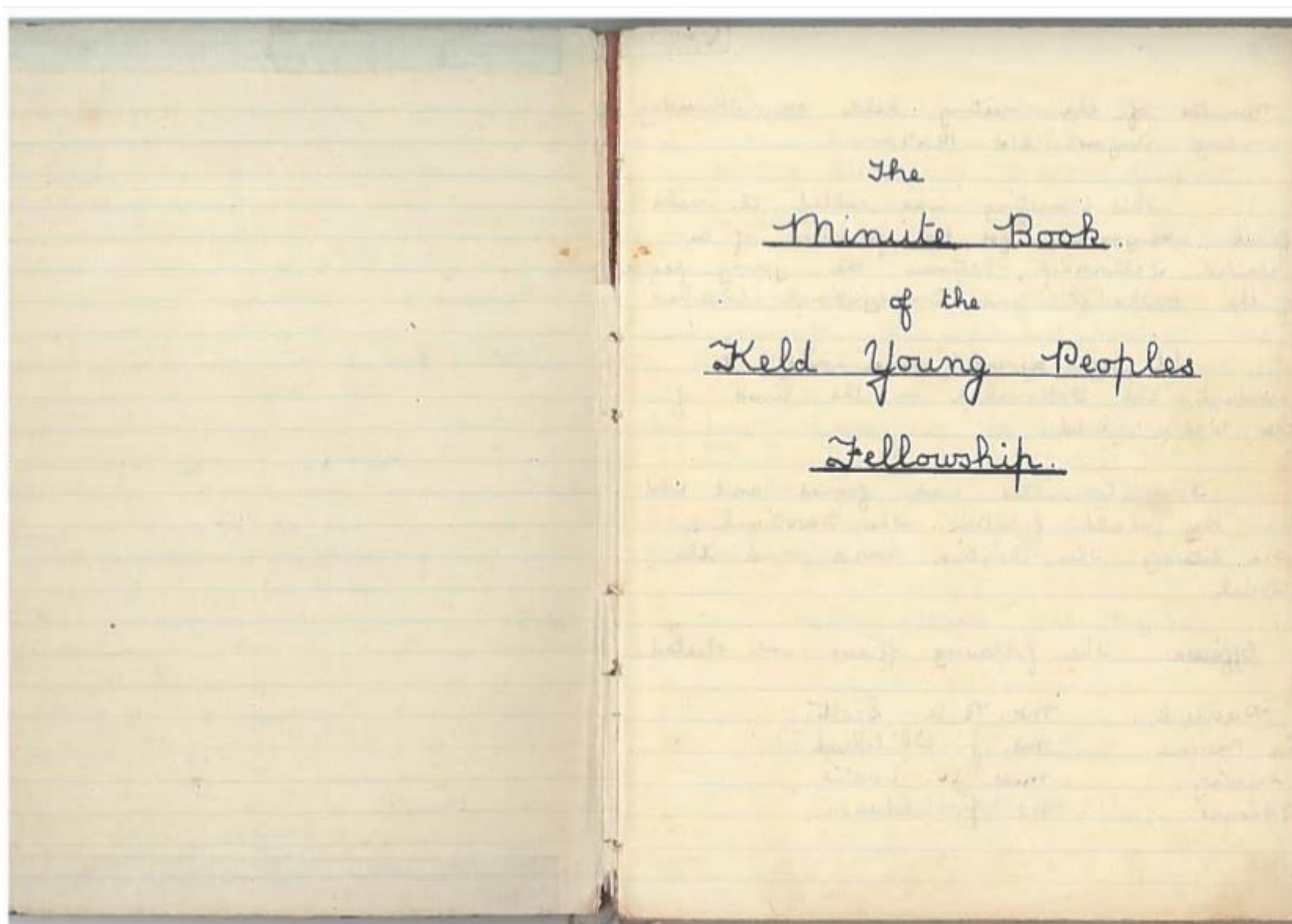

Minutes of the meeting held on Thursday evening August 21st. 1947.

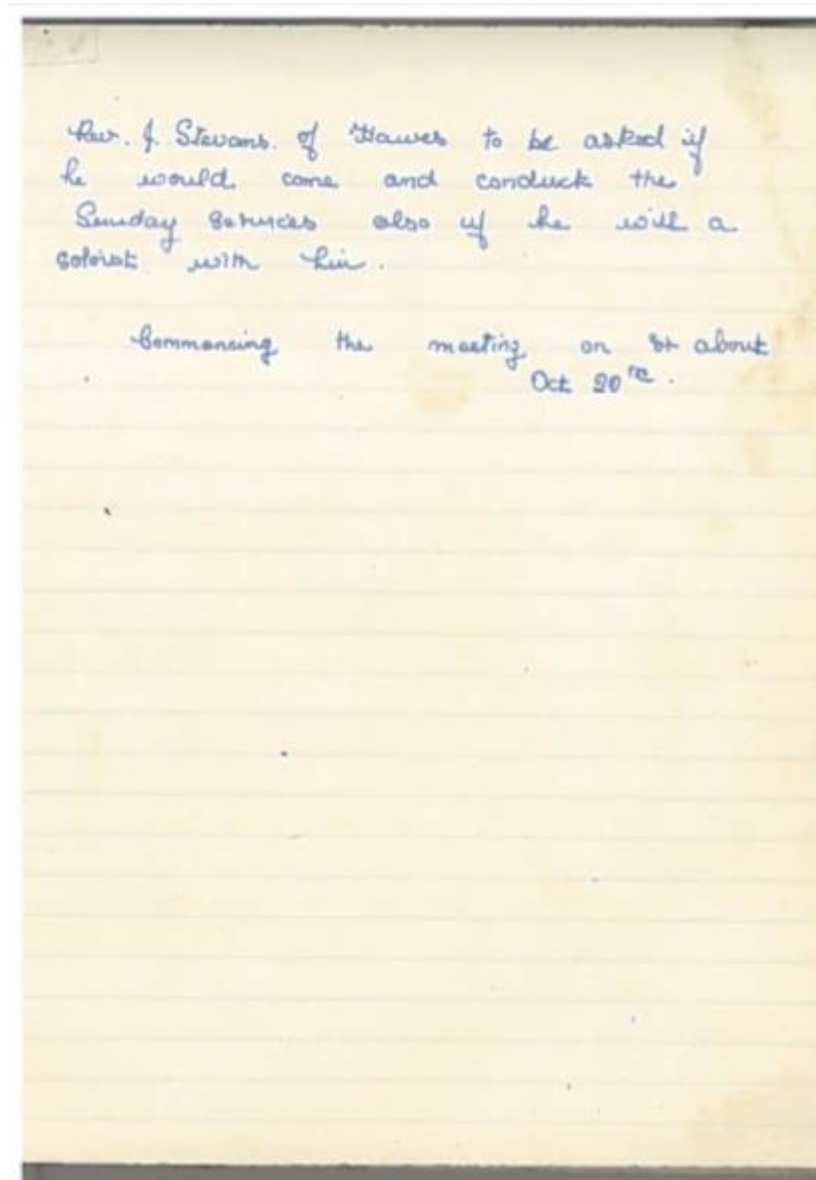
