Keld
via Richmond, Yks
8th May. 91.

Dear Sir,

We are now about
to appoint new Trustees for
Thraite Chapel, Keld School &
Literary Institute = all in one
deed.

I believe the deed is in your
possession. would you let
me if this is so?

We have a copy, and the
provisions for the appointment
of Trustees are to the following
effect: -
They have to be nominated

by two thirds of the male members
of Keld & Edwite Churches.
and approved by a majority
of the Seat-holders voting at
a meeting duly intimated on
the two previous Sundays.

We have got the nominations
over, and on Sunday next
I shall give the first intimation
for the meeting of Seat-holders.

Will you kindly inform me
what evidence of appointment
I shall require to present at
the Court in order to have
the new Trustees entered as
tenants?

I understand that a legal

document is required: if so
please say what the probable
cost would be. We are very
unable to meet a Legacy bill.

Mr. Conyers of Leeds is the only
survivor of the old Trustees, and
we intend to make up the
original number - nine.

I hope all can be got
ready for the Court at
Inches.
