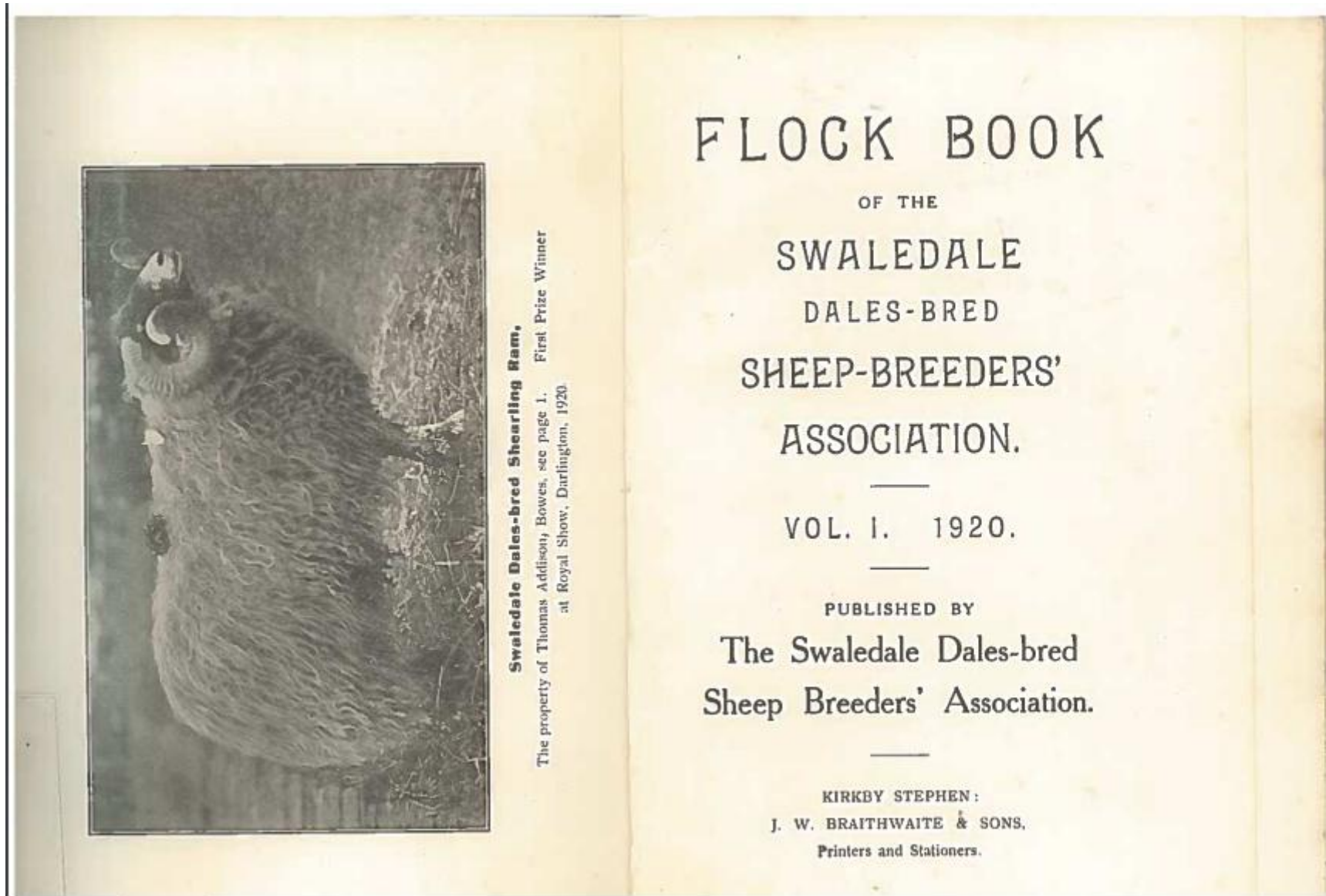
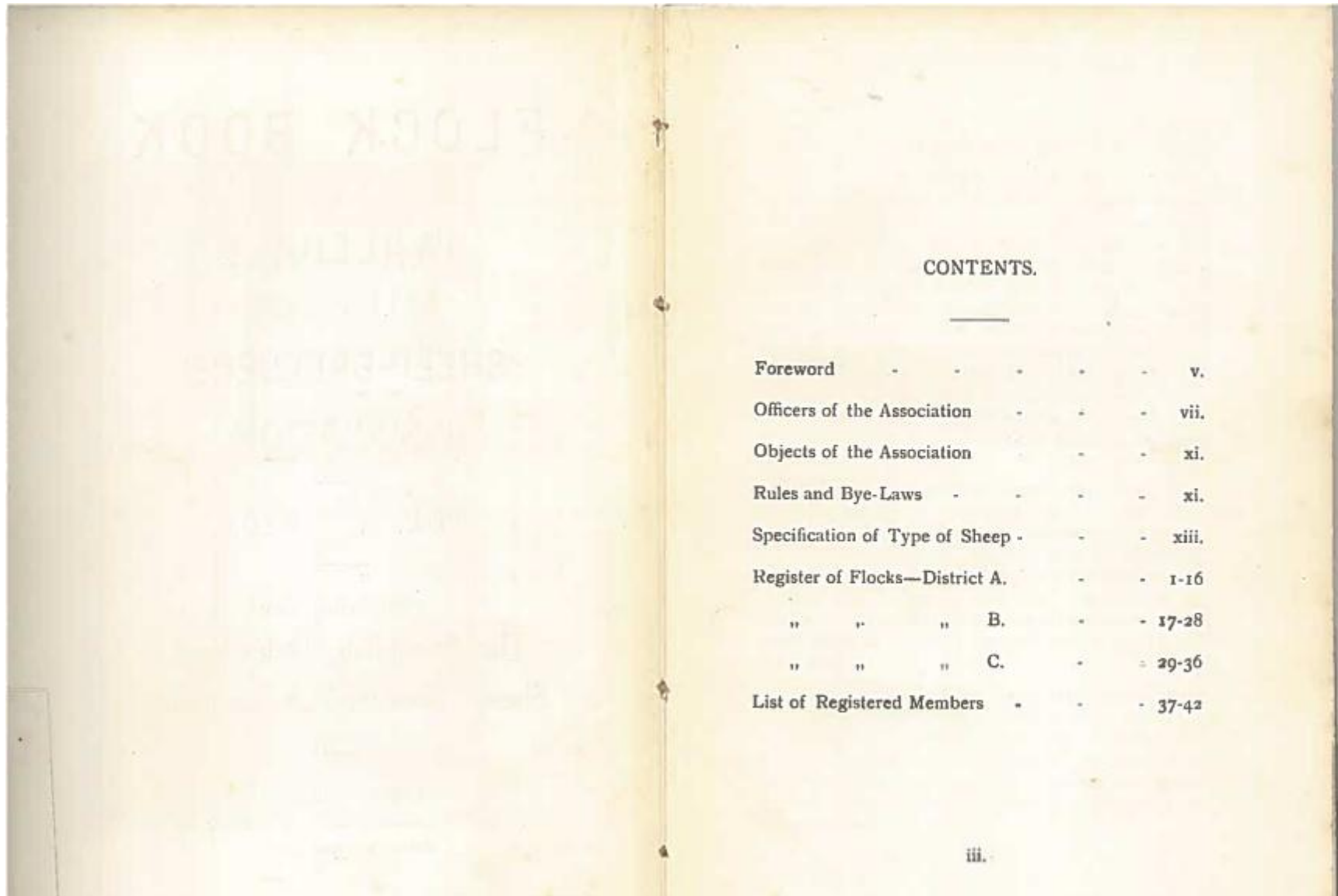


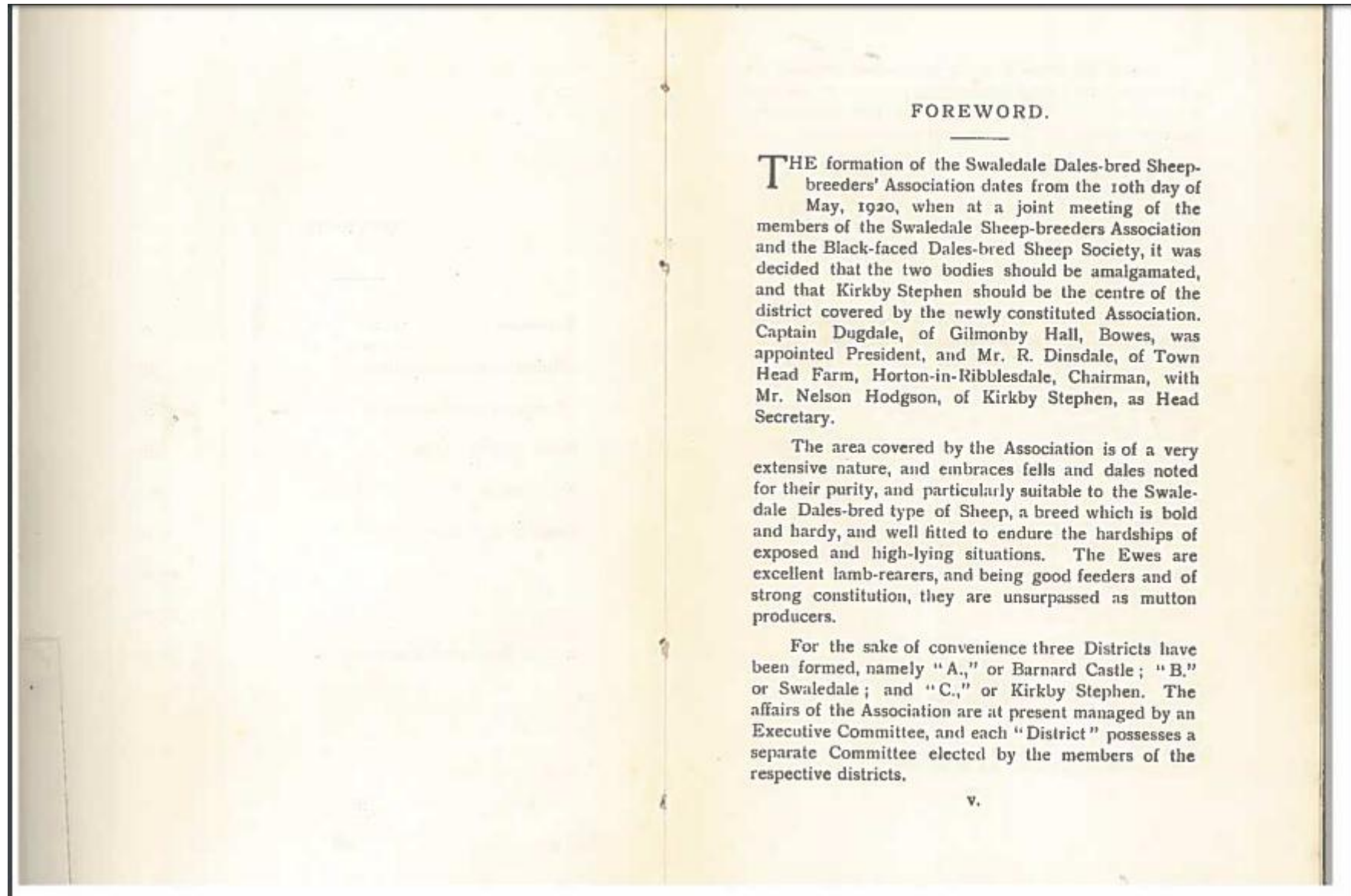

The Brand or mark of the Association consists of a Crown, all registered Rams being branded on the far horn with the Crown, District Letter, and consecutive number. Ewes are branded with the Crown only.

Owing to Mr. Nelson Hodgson having removed from Kirkby Stephen early in 1921, no meeting of the Committee was held between the 31st of January and the 29th of August, of last year, and the progress of the Association was consequently retarded. On the 12th September, 1921, Mr. Wm. Rees, of Kirkby Stephen, was appointed Head Secretary.

In presenting this the first Flock Book of the Association, the Editing Committee feels that it owes an apology for its somewhat belated appearance. Difficulties have, however, as above stated, been encountered, and considerable delay has been experienced in securing photographs of the winners in the 4 classes at the Royal Show, held at Darlington in 1920.

## Rules and Bye-Laws,

AND

### Objects of the Association.

The name of the Association is "The Swaledale Dales-bred Sheep Breeders' Association."

The Head Office of the Association is situate at Kirkby Stephen.

The objects for which the Association is established are:—

(a.) The encouragement of the breeding of Swaledale Dales-bred Sheep, and the maintenance of their purity.

(b.) The establishment and publication of a Flock Book of recognised and pure-bred sires, and the annual registration of the pedigrees of such sires as are proved to the satisfaction of the General Committee to be eligible for entry.

(c.) The investigation of cases of doubtful and suspected pedigrees, and the general protection of the interests of the breed.

### Rules and Bye-Laws.

1. Terms of Membership:—Each Member shall be a bona-fide Swaledale Dales-bred Sheep Breeder or Keeper, except Honorary Members, who subscribe annually not less than £1 1s. od., and shall be eligible to attend the Annual Meeting each year.

2. The annual subscription shall be 10/6 for small breeders of less than 100 Ewes, who shall be allowed to Register 25 or less; and £1 1s. od. for large breeders of more than 100 Ewes, who shall be allowed to Register 50. In addition a fee of 1/- per Ewe, and 2/- per Ram shall be paid for Registration.

3. The quorum of the Executive Committee shall be seven.

4. Two Members of the Association shall be appointed at the annual General Meeting to be auditors for the then ensuing year.

5. Any Member can on application to the Secretary obtain a copy of these Bye-laws, and will be deemed to have had full notice of all the clauses and conditions therein contained, and will be held bound by the same.

6. All disputes to be settled by the Executive Committee, whose decision shall be final.

7. Every Member shall, provided he has paid his Annual Subscription for the current year, be entitled to a copy of each of the Association's publications without further charge.

8. Each Member on joining the Association shall pay the annual subscription, and all subsequent annual subscriptions shall be considered as falling due on the 1st day of January in each year. Each Member shall also sign the Registration Form of the Association. Any Member wishing to withdraw from the Association may do so, provided that he gives notice in writing to the Secretary, at least 28 days prior to the 1st January in any year.

9. Members shall observe all bye-laws, regulations, and orders of the Association or the Executive Committee.

10. Any Member who shall neglect to pay any subscription, fine or forfeit, may be excluded from the Association.

11. All sheep of the Swaledale Dales-bred type, belonging to members of the Association, must be described as such upon all occasions.

12. Qualification for entry in the Flock Book shall be by means of an annual Inspection, conducted by Inspectors appointed by the Association, or the General Committee, or a District Committee.

## Specification of Type of Sheep.

**HEAD.**—The face is of medium length, strong in feature, with a tuft of wool on the forehead. The upper part of the face is dark complexioned, the lower part is grey or mealy. The eyes are quick and bright, the hair on face short and strong, a deep jaw and short broad teeth. This type of sheep grows greyer with age. Points, 10.

**HORNS AND EARS.**—Horns low set, round and rather wide. Ears are grey and of medium length. Points, 5.

**WOOL.**—White (except at back of head, where it is mixed with part black), with a thick deep bed with a curly top, medium length, not coarse, and which hangs down shanks. The wool has a good bind and fills the hand well. Points, 25.

**BODY.**—Medium length of neck, shoulders medium, and well-rounded ribs, chest well let down, broad level back, good firm loins, long-drawn hind quarters, and full in thigh. Points, 20.

**TAIL.**—Thick, long, and woolly. Points, 5.

LEGS.—Good flat bone of medium length, well set, and with well-shaped hocks. Grey or mottled in colour, and with good-sized feet. Walks well. Points, 15.

GENERAL.—The Swaledale sheep has proved itself to be a bold, hardy sheep, well fitted to endure the hardships of exposed and high-lying situations. It is of an alert nature and a good thriver. The Ewes make most excellent lamb-rearers. Their wool is admitted to be most durable in wear and of an even texture. Being excellent feeders and of a strong constitution, as mutton producers they stand second to none. Points, 20.
