The falls of the pend and the mill are bathed in lights. Another pond is located on the front lawn of the Schmidt home and here two life-sized deer have paused for a drink.

The trees surrounding the ponds are twinkling with small lights.

Johnsonville Road is situated Rtc. 151. (Leesville between Road and Rte. 149 (River Road) decorating the building with about a half mile south of the Frank Davis resort.
