A Message from Citizens For Equal Protection

Hello, right now it is great to be gay in America! Sounds as if I have finally lost my mind!

Actually, I just returned from Creating Change in St. Louis. Creating

Change, sponsored by the National Gay and Lesbian Task Force, is the largest GLBT conference in the world. I was asked to speak on our ballot initiative process Nebraska dealt with in 2000.

I was all geared up to rant about how no one was paying much attention to our plight when we lost Initiative 416 in 2000. I was all ready to scold national organizations for not supporting us on this issue. I took a deep breath and changed my mind. I advised each state to use the negative to create a positive and move forward with our work.

What we won in 2000, in Nebraska, was the beginning of the conversation around marriage and the inequality Amendment 29 created. What we won was identification of hundreds of GLBT folks in Nebraska and thousands of straight allies. Nebraska was the pioneer state on this issue and our lawsuit, challenging this amendment, may be the road to marriage equality.

I had hopeful conversations with leaders from the Task Force (NGLTF), Lambda Legal, The Federation (statewide GLBT political organizations and allies), Human Rights Campaign, the National Center for Transgender Equality, the ACLU and others. I listened to Roey Thorpe, Executive Director of Basic Rights Oregon, talk about hope for the future and how to keep loving each other and never give up the fight for equality. Basic Rights Oregon lost their marriage initiative by less that 7%.

Keith Boykin, former Special Assistant to President Clinton and the President of the National Black Justice Coalition (African American LGBT advocates), spoke to us about how to not ever give up on equality. His grandmother, a staunch Southern Baptist,





ICON's annual Food 4 Thought fundraiser brought together much of the Omaha community as well as supporters from Des Moines and Minneapolis.
