## Spain Gives Gay Couples Right to Wed

MADRID, Spain -- Parliament legalized gay marriage Thursday, defying conservatives and clergy who opposed making traditionally Roman Catholic Spain the third country to allow same-sex unions nationwide. Jubilant gay activists blew kisses to lawmakers after the vote.

The measure passed the 350-seat Congress of Deputies by a vote of 187 to 147. The bill, part of the ruling Socialists' aggressive agenda for social reform, also lets gay couples adopt children and inherit each others' property.

The bill is now law. The Senate, where conservatives hold the largest number of seats, rejected the bill last week. But it is an advisory body and final say on legislation rests with the Congress of Deputies.

After the final tally was announced, gay and lesbian activists watching from the spectator section of the ornate chamber cried, cheered, hugged, waved to lawmakers and blew them kisses.

Several members of the conservative opposition Popular Party, which was vehemently opposed to the bill, shouted: "This is a disgrace." Those in favor stood and clapped.

The Netherlands and Belgium are the only other two countries that allow gay marriage nationwide. Canada's House of Commons passed legislation Tuesday that would legalize gay marriage; its Senate is expected to pass the bill into law by the end of July.

Prime Minister Jose Luis Rodriguez Zapatero noted this in debate before the vote.

"We were not the first, but I am sure we will not be the last. After us will come many other countries, driven, ladies and gentlemen, by two unstoppable forces: freedom and equality," he told the chamber.

It must have been a long year for you! The favorite bar among local lesbians has been right under your nose this entire time! Just blocks west of the Rainbow Outreach GLBT Center is *Connections*. The address is 1901 Leavenworth Street. You will notice it with Rainbow Curtains in the windows and all the ladies around the building.

The best night to stop into *Connections* is Karaoke Night, which is every Thursday. Not only will you hear some great Karaoke (most of the time), the pool tables are hopping and the girls are out to party!

Parking can be tricky, so I recommend getting there early or checking the place out on another night to familiarize yourself with the area.

Where can I feel comfortable as a cross-dresser in Omaha? I don't want to go in some place where I am not accepted.

Zapatero said the reform of Spanish legal code simply adds one dry paragraph of legalese but means much more.

He called it "a small change in wording that means an immense change in the lives of thousands of citizens. We are not legislating, ladies and gentlemen, for remote unknown people. We are expanding opportunities for the happiness of our neighbors, our work colleagues, our friends, our relatives."

Zapatero lacks a majority in the chamber but got help from small regional-based parties that tend to be his allies.

Spanish gay couples can get married as soon as the law is published in the official government registry. This could come as early as Friday, or within two weeks at the latest, parliament's press office said.

Popular Party leader Mariano Rajoy said after the vote that Zapatero has deeply divided Spain and should have sought a consensus in parliament that recognized same-sex unions but didn't call them marriage. Rajoy said that if the vast majority of countries in the world don't accept gay marriage, including some run by Socialists, there must be a reason.

"I think the prime minister has committed a grave act of irresponsibility," Rajoy told reporters.

Beatriz Gimeno, a longtime leader of the gay rights movement in Spain, held back tears as she hugged her partner Boti after the vote.

"It is a historic day for the world's homosexuals. We have been fighting for many years," Gimeno said. "Now comes the hardest part, which is changing society's mentality."

The gay marriage bill was the boldest and most divisive initiative of the liberal social agenda Zapatero has embarked on since taking office in April 2004. Parliament overhauled Spain's 25-year-old divorce law on Wednesday, also irking the church, by letting couples end their marriage without a mandatory separation or having to state a reason for the split-up, as required under the old law.

He has also pushed through legislation allowing stem-cell research and wants to loosen Spain's restrictive abortion law.

The Roman Catholic Church, which held much sway over the government just a generation ago when Gen. Francisco Franco was in power, had adamantly opposed gay marriage. In its first display of anti-government activism in 20 years, it endorsed a June 18 rally in which hundreds of thousands marched through Madrid in opposition to the bill. Some 20 bishops took part in the June 18 rally.

On Wednesday, a Catholic lay group called the Spanish Family Forum presented lawmakers with a petition bearing 600,000 signatures as a last-minute protest.

Late last year, the spokesman for the Spanish Bishops Conference, Antonio Martinez Camino said that allowing gay marriage was like "imposing a virus on society -- something false that will have negative consequences for social life."

Despite the street protests in Madrid and elsewhere and the petition drive, polls suggest Spaniards support gay marriage.

A survey released in May by pollster Instituto Opina said 62 percent of Spaniards support the government's action on this issue, and 30 percent oppose it. The poll had a margin of error of 3 percentage points. But surveys show Spaniards about evenly split over whether gay couples should be allowed to adopt children.

## A Special Message From CFEP

I would like to take this opportunity to say thank you all for supporting Citizens For Equal Protection over the past several years. I would also like to say thanks for letting me represent our community in the Unicameral, schools where I have spoken, teachers and students I have worked with and all of the other ways I have helped to advance GLBT civil rights in Nebraska.

We have so many victories, so many advancements and so many moments to take pride in this past year. One Thursday in May, before noon, Senator Ernie Chambers passed an amendment to an appropriations bill that adds requires research institutions that receive state funding to add sexual orientation to their non-discrimination policies. And, at about 11 AM on that same day WE WON THE LAWSUIT CHALLENGING AMENDMENT 29-FORMERLY INITIATIVE 416!!!!

And that is just part of it! Nebraska, with major help from the Victory Fund, a national organization that helps elect openly

gay officials, now has our first openly gay elected official! Barb Baier, of Lincoln, is a newly elected school board member.

In April, I traveled to Philadelphia to represent Nebraska in the Equality Forum. The Equality Forum held the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first march on Philadelphia for GLBT rights. They honored 40 individuals who helped advance GLBT civil rights. The first march had about 45 in attendance and this year over 20,000 came to the rally.

CFEP co-hosted the first GLBT Summit at Mahoney State park this spring. We had a day of presentations by several organizations, discussions on GLBT civil rights and a lot of fun! We have two more scheduled-one in Grand Island in the fall and another at Mahoney in the spring.

Polling. CFEP hired a local polling firm, through the University of Lincoln, that queried 1,800 Nebraskans how they felt about sexual orientation protection in the workplace and housing. I am happy to announce that each district had a positive response of over 60%-most districts in the 70-80% range!

CFEP will hold our third annual fundraiser, a comedy show, Seriously Funny. This year we are returning to Hot Shops, located at 13<sup>th</sup> and Nicholas. T. Marni Voss, a local talent from Lincoln, will perform for us on October 1<sup>st</sup>. Doors open at 6:30 and the show begins at 8 PM. We will have a silent auction, appetizers and cash bar. Tickets are \$25. Please show your support by attending. I promise you will have a great time!

Many Omaha area gay and lesbian homeowners who have had trouble with credit cards and so on have found that there is *one* place in Omaha where they can be treated with respect.

No “better than you” attitude, no “b.s.,” no guilt just for being gay or lesbian.

At last, finding financial help doesn't have to be like a “coming out” at Thanksgiving dinner with everyone pointing fingers, and finding fault.

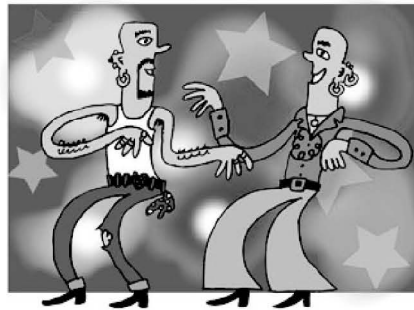

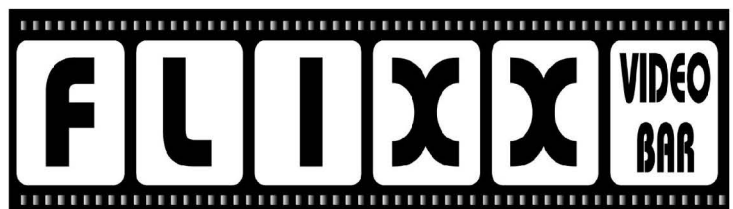
