HRC SAYS DEFECTION OF 'EX-GAY' LEADER SHOWS LACK OF CREDIBILITY

The Human Rights Campaign urged Exodus International, the world's largest chain of "ex-gay" ministries, to follow the lead of Jeremy Marks, a former "ex-gay" leader. Marks, the head of an Exodus affiliate in the United Kingdom, who announced in an interview with *gay.com* that his ministry was "taking a two-year sabbatical" to focus on "supporting Christians who are gay."

"It took a lot of strength and conviction for Marks to come forward and tell the truth -- that people in the 'ex-gay' ministries are not changing their sexual orientation," said Wayne Besen, an HRC spokesperson. "This latest failure presents a wonderful opportunity for Exodus members to reevaluate their mission and to begin an honest dialogue with themselves and the public."

Marks told *gay.com*, the Internet news service, that his 14 years of conversion therapy slowly made him realize that the process fails to change sexual orientation. "None of the people we've counseled have converted, no matter how much effort and prayer they've put into it," said Marks. "There is much more benefit to the more honest view." Marks praised the sincerity of Exodus members but called the "ex-gay" rhetoric destructive. "Ex-gay" ministries maintain that it is impossible to be a Christian and to live as an openly gay person

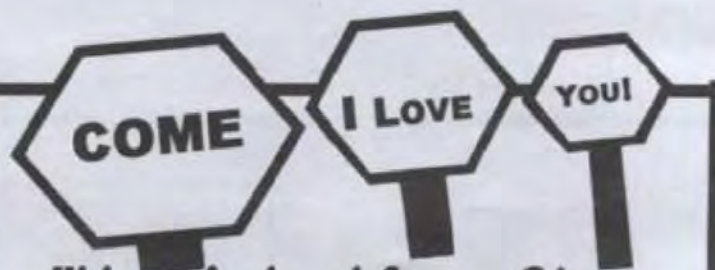

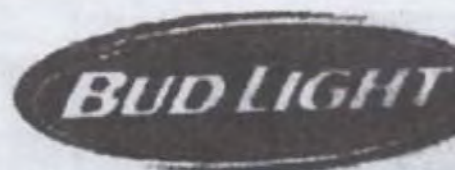

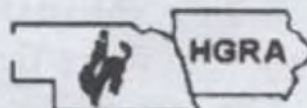
